Welcome to the Fall 2022 National City Newsletter. We are back in person, and it has been so rewarding to see our citizens reengaging in community events, programs, and city council meetings. We are excited to announce

the City will celebrate its 136th Birthday on September 17th!

In conjunction with our partners, the City held the Groundbreaking Ceremony for our Kimball Highland Master Plan. The area is anticipated to be under construction until the end of 2023. The Kimball Highland Master Plan is a unique urban village developed along Kimball Way, less than half a mile from City Hall.

The Kimball Highland Master Plan will have walkable access to existing local retail, transit, and city resources in the intergenerational neighborhood. Most importantly, this plan also includes a brand new, state-of-the-art facility for our Senior Services. In the interim, the City will provide senior programming at Casa de Sauld and the National City Public Library during construction.

We look forward to seeing you at our community events and encourage you to sign up for our citywide programs.






