

#### DISTRICTING NATIONAL CITY

On December 21, 2021, the National City Council voted to change the way City Council members are elected, transitioning from at-large elections for City Council members, creating districts within the city and adopting a district boundary map.







#### **UP AND COMING PROJECTS IN YOUR AREA**

#### Street Resurfacing CIP No. 22-19

This project follows the priorities identified in the City's Pavement Management Program. In this cycle, the following streets will be resurfaced:

- Mann Avenue (Nov 21 -Feb 24) -Grind and overlay to resurface street, and provide additional pedestrian ramps and crossing
- Fire Squad Station 33 (Dec 9 -Feb 22) -Provide a new concrete driveway for emergency vehicle parking
- **E. Plaza Boulevard** (Jan 11 -Feb 23) -Grind and overlay to resurface street, remove and replace damaged curb and gutter, and provide new concrete bus pads
- National City Boulevard (Feb 16 -Apr 3) -Grind and overlay to resurface street, upgrade pedestrian ramps for ADA compliance
- E. 16th Street (Apr 4 -Apr 10) -Grind and overlay to resurface street, upgrade pedestrian ramps for ADA compliance
- Roosevelt Avenue (Apr 11 -May 3) -Grind and overlay to resurface street, remove and replace damaged curb and gutter and remove and replace concrete driveways

#### P1 Sewer Upsize Project Phase 2 CIP No. 20-01

This project will replace approximately 600 linear feet of existing 8-inch sewer main with new 12-inch sewer main to meet the current and future demand.

- **30th Street from National City Blvd to A Ave** (Feb 13 March 31) Removal and replacement of pipe, including trenching in street and restoration of roadway
- "Duck Pond" north of A Ave (April/May) Replacement of sewer line using a subsurface trenchless technique



#### Sweetwater Road Bikeway Project CIP No. 19-20

The Sweetwater Road Bikeway project will provide nearly 1.2 miles of protected bike facilities along Sweetwater Road and extend the Class 1 bike path on Plaza Bonita Road to Sweetwater Road (0.4 miles). The project will include a road diet, bicycle-friendly intersection improvements, and pedestrian enhancements. The proposed bicycle facilities will directly link the City's bike network to the regional network.

- Sweetwater Road & Plaza Bonita Road (Jan 23 May 12) Construct Concrete Sidewalks, Bike Paths, Curbs and Gutters, and Pedestrian Ramps
- Plaza Bonita Road (Jan 30 Feb 18) Storm drain upgrades & water relocations, install storm drainpipe, excavate, and build
  new storm drain curb inlet
- Intersections at Sweetwater Road & Orange Street, Valley Road, and Plaza Bonita Road (Feb 6 March 23) Install traffic signal pedestrian hybrid beacon system and perform traffic signal modifications
- Sweetwater Road (April 3 June 30) Traffic signal modifications at I-805 on and off ramp
- Sweetwater Road Between Orange Street & Cypress Street (Apr 17 May 19) Construct bus stop, median with sidewalk, and pedestrian passageway
- Sweetwater Road & Plaza Bonita Road (April 24 June 22) Soil preparation and planting, install new landscaping irrigation system
- **Sweetwater Road & Plaza Bonita Road** (May 1 June 30) Pavement improvements including crack sealing & slurry sealing, milling, asphalt paving, new striping, and new signage



#### SAN DIEGO COMMUNITY POWER



Last year, the City joined San Diego Community Power (SDCP) to provide the community with new energy options, and the choice to commit to cleaner renewable power.

National City customers are scheduled to begin enrollment to SDCP this April. Residents

and businesses will begin receiving information in the mail about the switch to San Diego Community Power.

San Diego Community Power works by replacing SDG&E's generation service. As seen in the graphic above, SDCP purchases renewable energy on behalf of our customers, the power is transmitted and delivered through SDG&E infrastructure, and, ultimately the customer receives cleaner more renewable power.

- Total paid for daycare provider and the daycare provider's tax identifying number (the provider's Social Security number or the provider's business Employer Identification Number).

If you are married filing jointly, both spouses must be available to sign all forms. No exceptions.
