EXPENSIVE SEWER BACKUPS CAN BE PREVENTED!



Wipes BLOCK Pipes!

Flushable wipes are a leading cause of costly clogs and sewer spills. They snag on imperfections in sewer pipes, catch passing debris and create massive problems. Even if they say "flushable," do not flush wipes.

FOG Clogs TOO

Fats, Oils and Grease from cooking and cleaning pans/dishes also clog pipes. Instead, wipe cooled grease from your pan and put it in the trash. Or carefully pour cooled oil in an empty can/jar and then in the trash.

Blocked pipes cause expensive repairs, pose public health risks and can overflow into private homes.

PLEASE TAKE ACTION - Only allow toilet paper down the drain!



Current and Upcoming Projects in your Parks!

Kimball Park Dog Park & Tot Lot and Las Palmas Park Dog Park CIP No. 23-06

This project will construct new dog parks at both Kimball Park and Las Palmas Park, as well as a new tot lot playground, a batting cage, lighting improvements and a public art installation at Kimball Park. Construction is underway and will be completed in Spring 2024*.




Current and Upcoming Projects in your Parks!(Cont'd)

El Toyon Park Improvements Project CIP 22-26

This project is funded by Prop 68, the State of California Parks & Water Bond of 2018 through a competitive grant from the Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Program.

The project will *construct* a community event and farmers market area, pickleball courts with fencing, community garden, Class I bikeway, walking paths, new shade structures, new scoreboard, public art, sports warm up area, a gateway entry, security cameras, new lighting, landscaping and signage throughout the park.

In addition, this project will also *renovate* existing tennis courts, artificial turf sports field, basketball courts, dog park, playground, fitness area, bleachers, parking lot, and restrooms.



Anticipated Timeline*

- Finalize Design: October 2023
- Advertise Project for Bid: November 2023
- Award Contract: February 2024
- Begin Construction: February 2024
- Complete Construction: February 2025

ORGANICS RECYCLING



Food Scraps

Cooked or raw meat, poultry and seafood (including bones), cheese, dairy products, fruits, vegetables, grains, pasta, egg shells, bread, coffee grounds, tea bags, tea leaves, baked goods, nuts, jelly, candy, snack foods, leftovers and spoiled food.

Food-Soiled Paper

Paper bags, paper napkins, paper towels, paper plates, paper cups, paper take-out containers and take-out boxes (with no plastic or wax coating, and with metal removed), coffee filters and tissues.

Natural Fibers

Popsicle sticks, wooden toothpicks, wooden chopsticks, wooden stirrers and untreated wood.

Landscape Waste

Plants, leaves, branches, grass




