# **Agenda Items**

1. Approval of the Minutes from the meeting of October 6, 2011

Committee member Cate moved to approve the minutes as corrected to reflect that Chair Cox is responsible for the section of the report related to actions taken to improve and/or stabilize the General Fund; and the summary. After a second from Committee member Nielsen, the minutes were unanimously approved.

## 2. Discussion – Review of financial data

Committee members stated that they are satisfied with the data that has been received to date. Committee member Cate noted that if he receives the deferred maintenance data in time, he will include the numbers and a description in his section of the report. Chair Cox requested information on temporary verses permanent changes that the City has made in its efforts to close the deficit.

3. Discussion – Outline of report sections

Committee members reviewed their individual sections of the report. Committee member Nielsen noted that that City's General Fund needs to start showing a surplus in each of these five years, adding that the district tax should be used to pay for things that do not create an on-going commitment.

Committee member Cate noted that in looking at the General Fund over the last ten years, a significant cost has been the pension system. Committee member Cate suggested that the City request a projection of retirement costs for the next ten to fifteen years, adding that the City also needs to know the cost of fully funded health care and the cost to catch up deferred maintenance for the purpose of creating policy and target goals.
