CITY LIBRARIAN'S REPORT

- 1. **Collection Agency.** FCN, the collection agency whose service the City has engaged to recover unpaid library fees/fines, has started to send its first batch of demand letters on March 26th. Patrons contacted by FCN are those who have incurred fees and fines in the amount of \$20 and higher. Once accounts are sent to collections, patrons are strongly encouraged to deal with the collection agency directly to settle the debt or work out a payment plan. As permitted by law, the collection agency can charge interest on the debts it is collecting. It is important to note that at this time, FCN has been instructed by the City to refrain from reporting accounts to credit bureau agencies.
- **2. Tech Lab.** Scott Zimmer, the Technology Librarian, has completed the setup of the 3D printer Lab with the help of IT staff. He is currently working on gathering and testing out various 3D design software and applications. The thought behind the Tech Lab is not about offering 3D print service. It's about fostering curiosity, nurturing creative expression, and providing a venue for techies and curious minds young and old to create, design, and tinker at leisure.
