2. Benny Adler. Business Manager, 2. McDini's, 105 East 8th Street, stated that they wish to make the business into a coffee shop, open 24/7. He wants McDini's to be a place where you can bring your kids and grandkids, families and military. further stated that they want to be competitive with Downtown San Diego in the area of booking national music talents with having musical entertainment seven nights a week, and to allow dancing.

Paris Hagman, project architect, addressed proposed architectural upgrades and landscaping proposed for the project.

Chairman Alvarado asked if the conditions of approval have been read and can be complied with.

Mr. Adler stated that the conditions can be met.

Sgt. Graham Young, National City Police Department, stated that stings conducted at McDini's have passed. Adding music seven days a week could become a drain on Police resources. He stated that dancing has occurred, when dancing is allowed at the business.
