1. ITEM NO. 2018-37

REQUEST TO INSTALL A BLUE CURB DISABLED PERSONS PARKING SPACE WITH SIGNAGE IN FRONT OF THE RESIDENCE AT 918 DELTA STREET

Mrs. Elia Gastelum, resident, was present to speak on behalf of this item.

Mrs. Gastelum stated that she has problems with finding parking in her neighborhood.

Ms. Carla Hutchinson, Assistant Engineer– Civil, provided the staff report for this item.

Committee Member Moon asked for confirmation on where the measurement was made. Ms. Hutchinson verified the measurement made was the extent of the driveway.

Committee Chairman Whipple asked city staff to provide status of the updates on the Council policy. Ms. Hutchinson and Mr. Luca Zappiello, Assistant Engineer – Junior, replied that the City Engineer and staff are still working on updates.

Committee Member Sherman asked if there was possibility of a parking permit district in the National City portion of this street. Mr. Zappiello responded that a request would have to be initiated by residents.

2. ITEM NO. 2018-38

REQUEST TO INSTALL A BLUE CURB DISABLED PERSONS PARKING SPACE WITH SIGNAGE IN FRONT OF THE RESIDENCE AT 2104 "I" AVENUE.

Resident Mrs. Dolores Scruggs and Mr. Manuel Mejia were present to speak on behalf of this item.

Mrs. Scruggs stated her concern for safety and parking in her neighborhood. Mr. Mejia added that there is a lot of parking congestion due to two local church services and their functions.

Ms. Carla Hutchinson, Assistant Engineer– Civil, provided the staff report for this item.

Committee Member Sherman asked why staff does not want to approve recommendation for this item. Ms. Hutchinson replied that the garage width is large enough to park a vehicle inside and the measurement of the slope incline.

Committee members discussed the height of the garage being too short for the resident's vehicle, but the dimensions on the policy do not state height requirements.

There was no public opposition to this item.

Action: Motion by Moon, 2nd by Sherman to go against staff recommendation and recommend installation of a blue curb disabled persons parking space with signage in front of the residence located at 2104 "I" Avenue.
