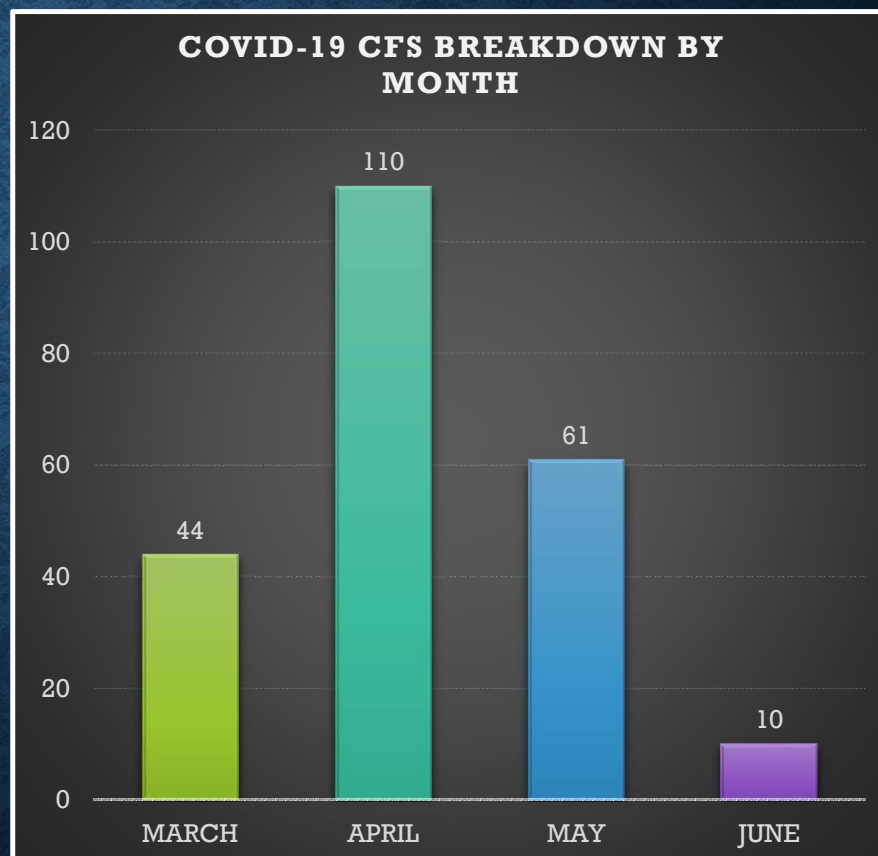

# COVID-19 CALLS FOR SERVICE HISTORY

- **“LONG TERM INCIDENT” CALL TYPE WAS OFFICIALLY CREATED ON APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup> IN ORDER TO TRACK COVID-19 RELATED CALLS FOR SERVICE**
- **BEFORE OFFICIALLY BECOMING A CALL TYPE CODE, COVID-19 RELATED CALLS FOR SERVICE WERE KEPT TRACK OF ON A SPREADSHEET IN DISPATCH**
- **ONLY USING THE CALL TYPE CODE AS A SEARCH PARAMETER, THERE HAVE BEEN 156 COVID-19 RELATED CALLS FOR SERVICE**
- **COMBINING THE CALLS FOR SERVICE FROM THE SPREADSHEET AND THE CALL TYPE CODE, THERE HAVE BEEN APPROXIMATELY 225 COVID-19 RELATED CALLS FOR SERVICE**
- **CALLS USUALLY CONTAINED QUESTIONS ABOUT WEARING MASKS, REPORTING BUSINESSES OR NEIGHBORS WHO ARE NON-COMPLIANT, GROUP GATHERINGS, ETC.**

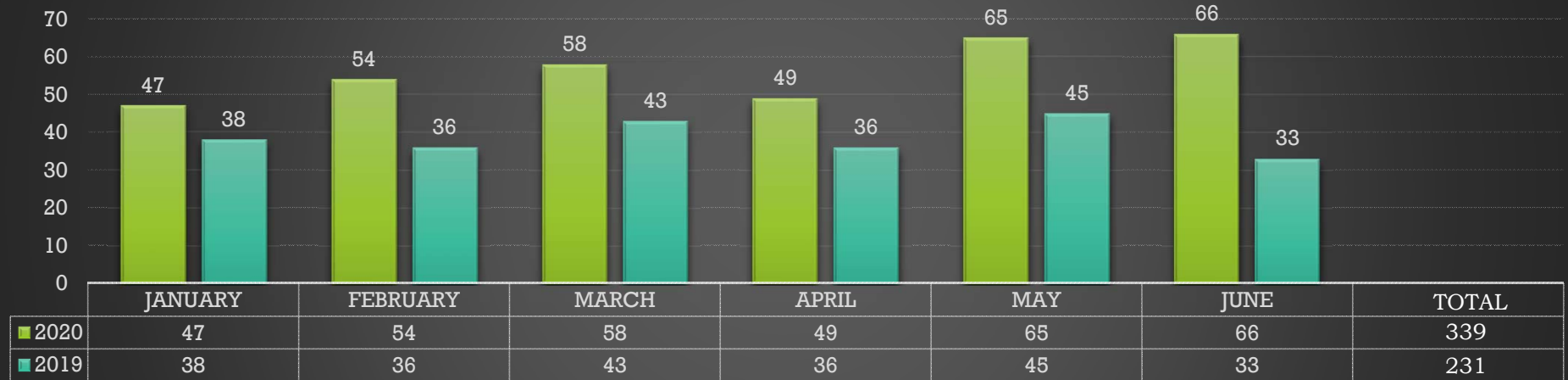

## DV CASES BY MONTH

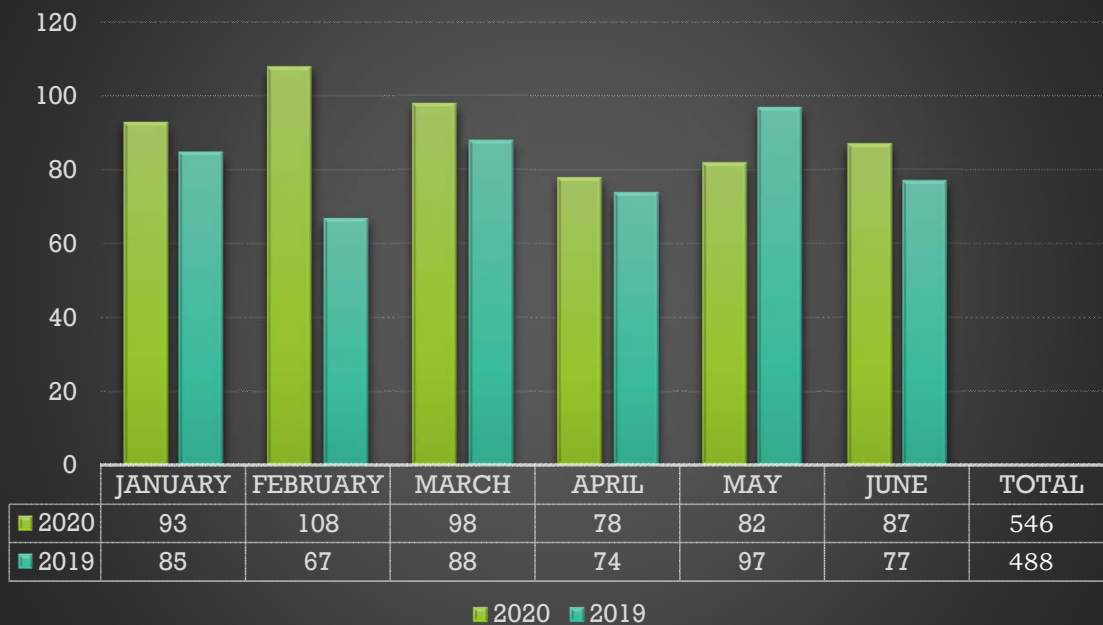

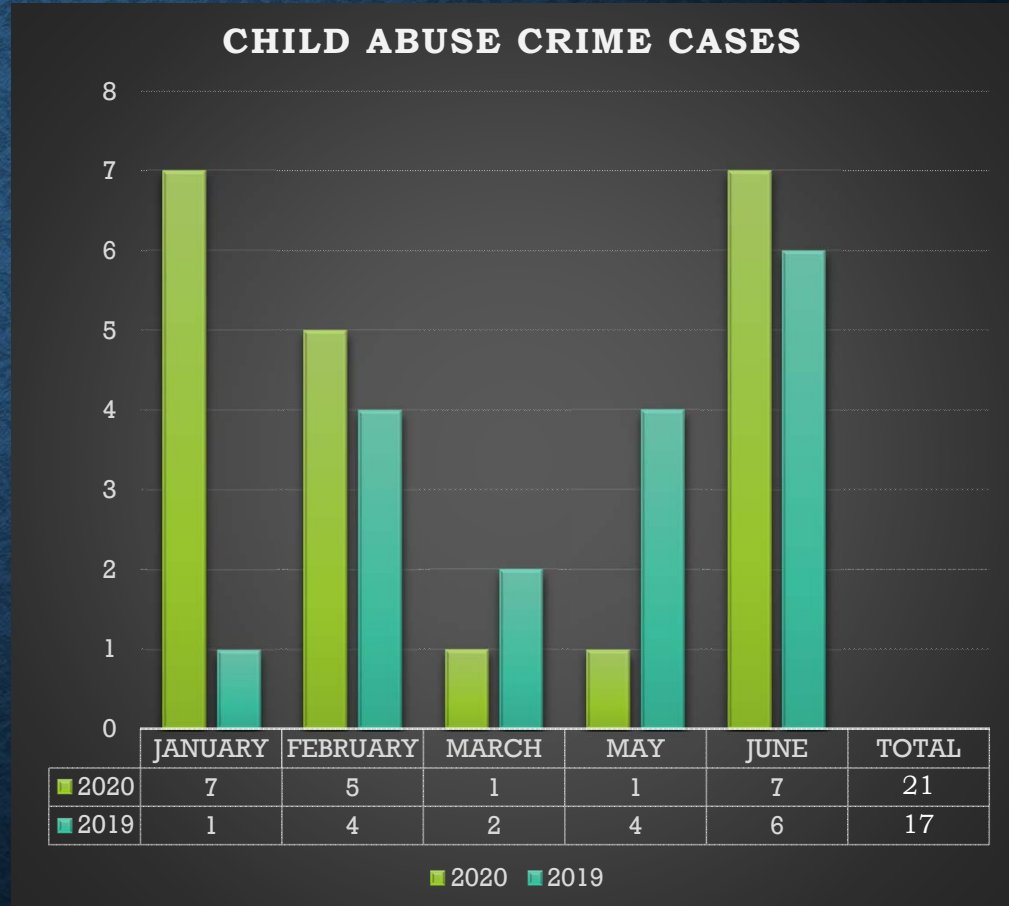

- **THERE HAVE BEEN FEWER CHILD ABUSE CALLS FOR SERVICE THIS YEAR COMPARED TO LAST YEAR**
- **ON THE SURFACE THIS LOOKS PROMISING**
- **HOWEVER, THIS DECREASE COULD BE A RESULT OF SCHOOL CLOSURES FOR COVID (NO REPORTING FROM TEACHERS, WHICH WOULD HAVE BEEN REPORTED IF STUDENTS WERE IN SCHOOL)**
- **DESPITE CHILD ABUSE CALLS FOR SERVICE DECREASING, THE NUMBER OF CHILD ABUSE CRIME CASES HAVE INCREASED**

# USE OF FORCE

## DEFINITIONS OF FORCE OPTIONS

**DEFENSIVE TACTICS** DEFENSIVE TACTICS ARE THOSE PHYSICAL TECHNIQUES INTENDED FOR USE WHEN WEAPONS ARE NOT AVAILABLE OR THEIR USE IS INADVISABLE OR UNREASONABLE UNDER THE CIRCUMSTANCES.

**IMPACT WEAPONS** INCLUDE THE USE OF BATONS, AND FLASHLIGHTS AS A MEANS OF DELIVERING A STRIKE TO A SUBJECT

**LESS LETHAL** INCLUDES THE USE OF NON-LETHAL CHEMICAL AGENTS LIKE OC PEPPER SPRAY AND PEPPER BALL LAUNCHER. OTHER LESS LETHAL WEAPONS INCLUDE THE USE OF THE 12 GAUGE BEAN BAG, STING BALL GRENADES, 37 MM AND 40 MM LAUNCHER, SINGLE SHOT, SHOULDER FIRED WEAPONS AND TASERS.

**LETHAL FORCE** IS THE INTENTIONAL DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM OR OTHER FORCE THAT CAUSES DEATH OR SERIOUS BODILY INJURY.

**CANINE** IS A TOOL THAT IS USED BY A K-9 HANDLER TO APPREHEND FLEEING OR COMBATIVE SUBJECTS.

**CONTROL HOLD** INCLUDES GRAB, PUSH OR PULL, PRESSURE POINTS AND LATERAL VASCULAR NECK RESTRAINT (LVNR) TECHNIQUES.

**OTHER** INCLUDES ALL OTHER FORCE OPTIONS NOT LISTED ABOVE, SUCH AS THE USE OF A CORD CUFF RESTRAINT OR HAND AND FOOT STRIKES.
