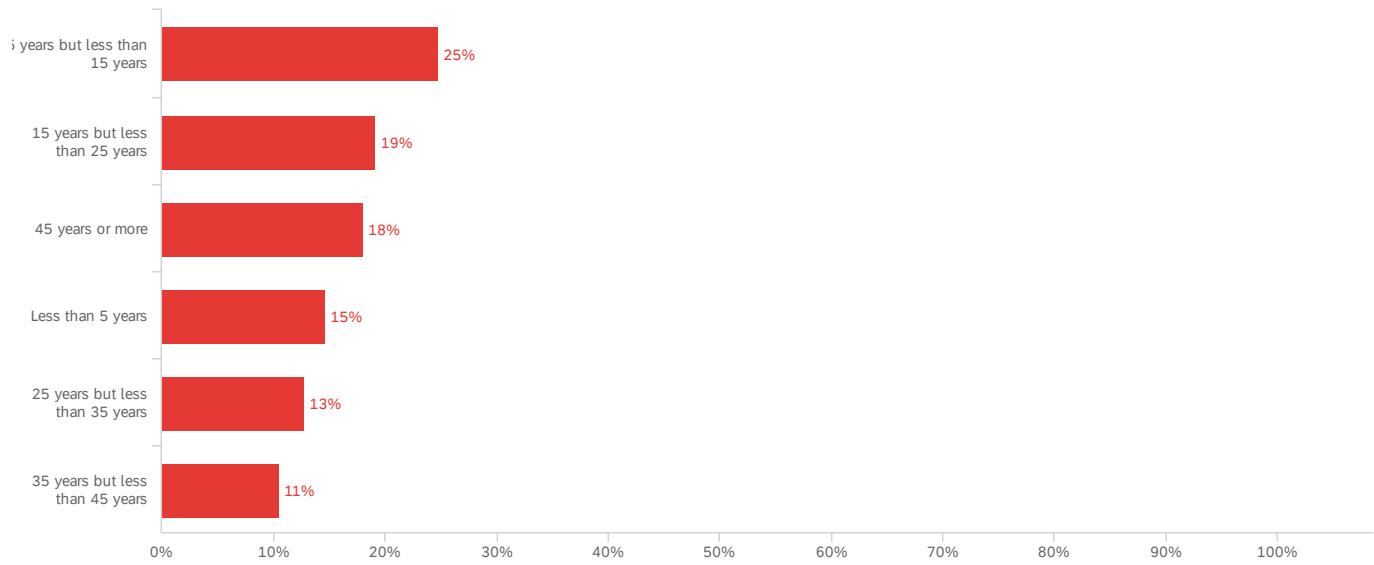

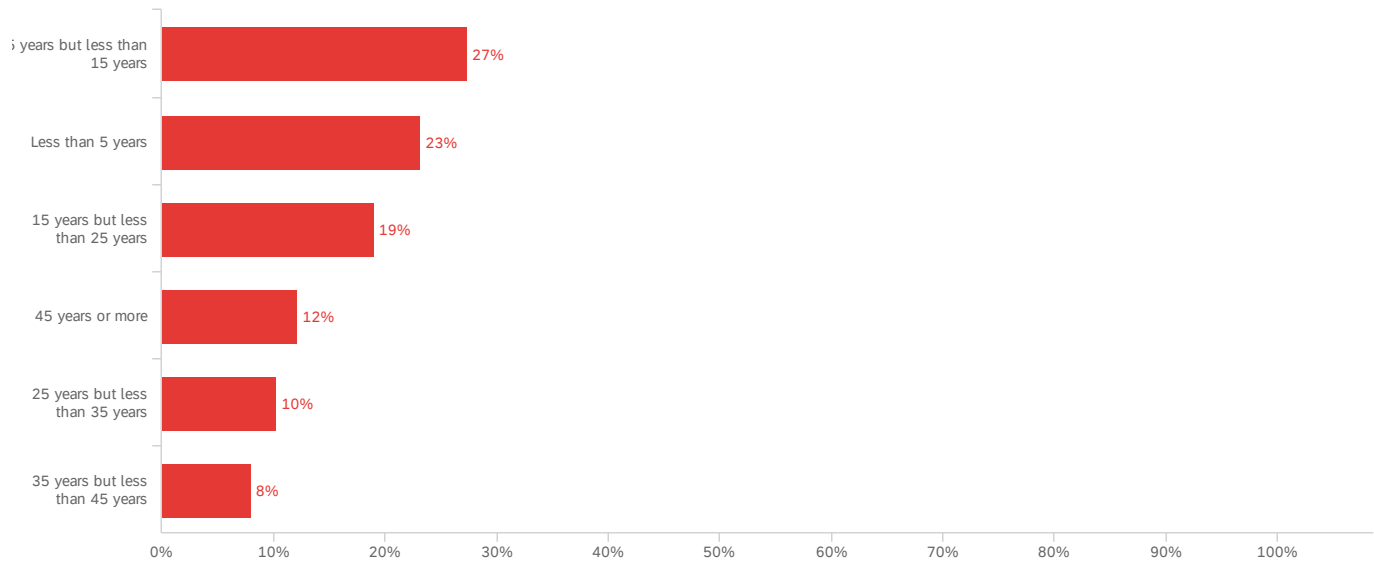
Q2.3 - How long have you lived in your community?

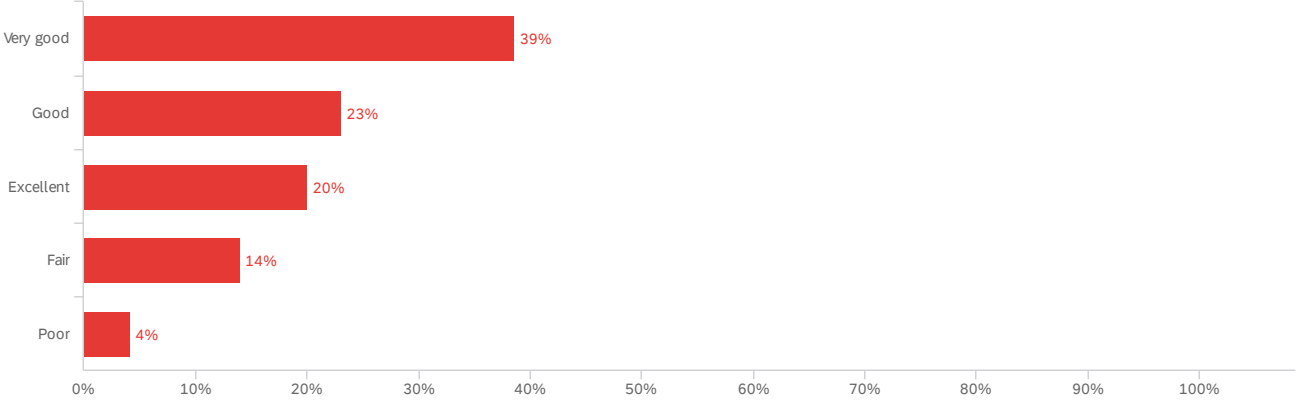
Q2.4 - How long have you lived in your current residence?

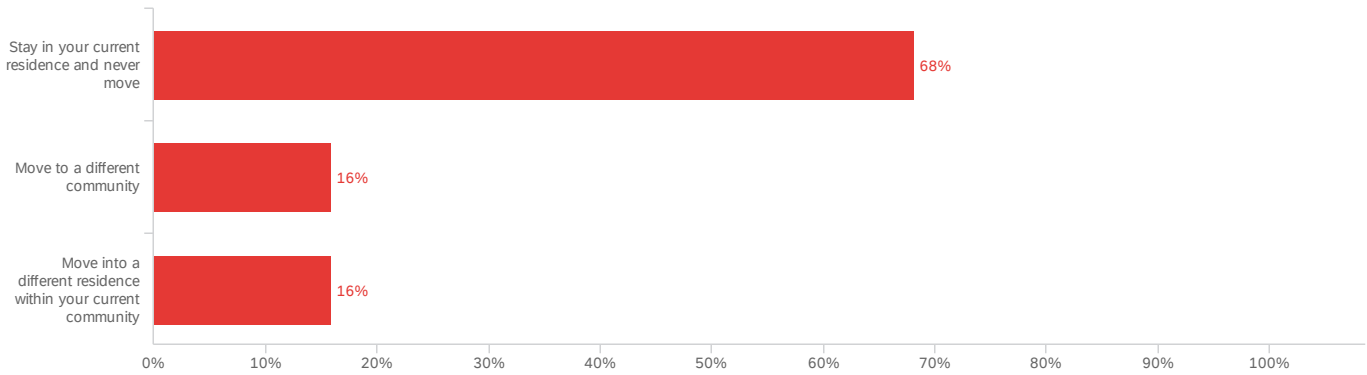
Q2.5 - How would you rate your current community as a place for people to live as they age?

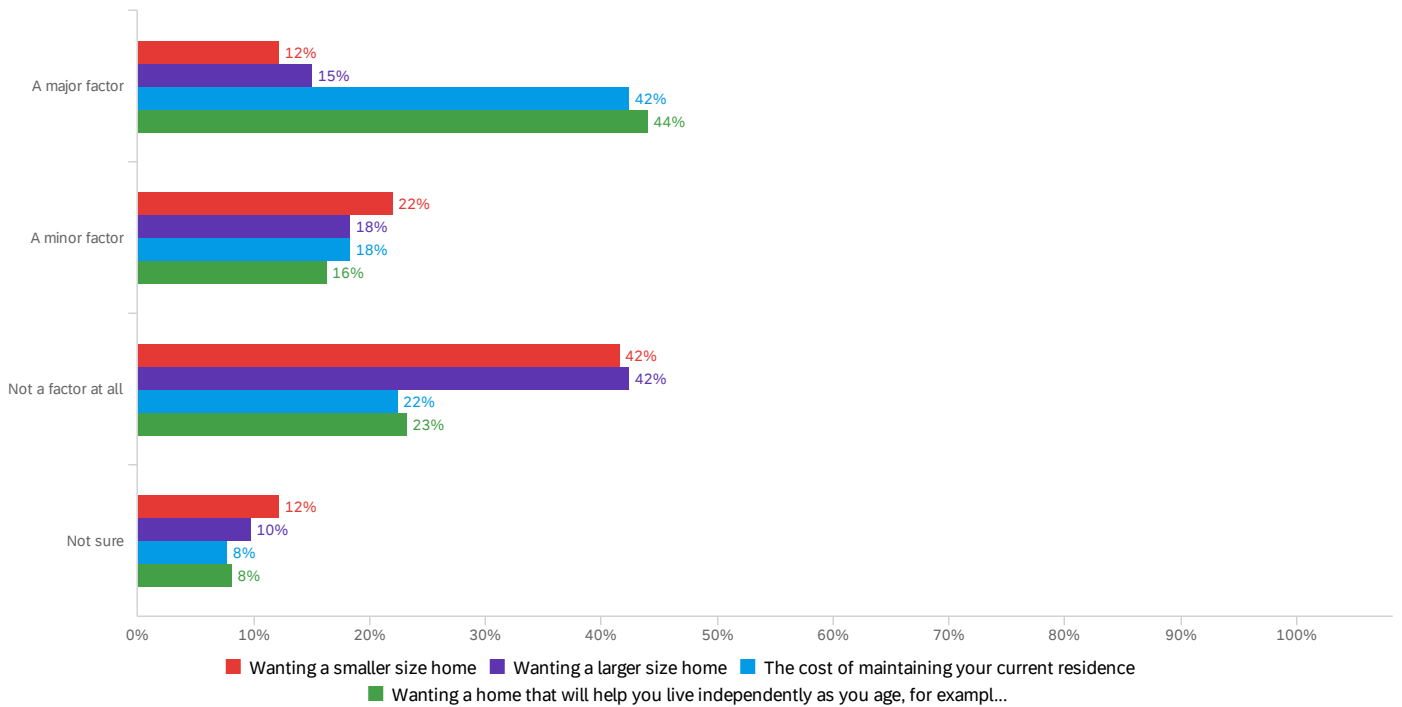
Q2.6 - Thinking about your future years, are you more likely to move to a different community, move to a different residence within your current community or stay in your current residence and never move?

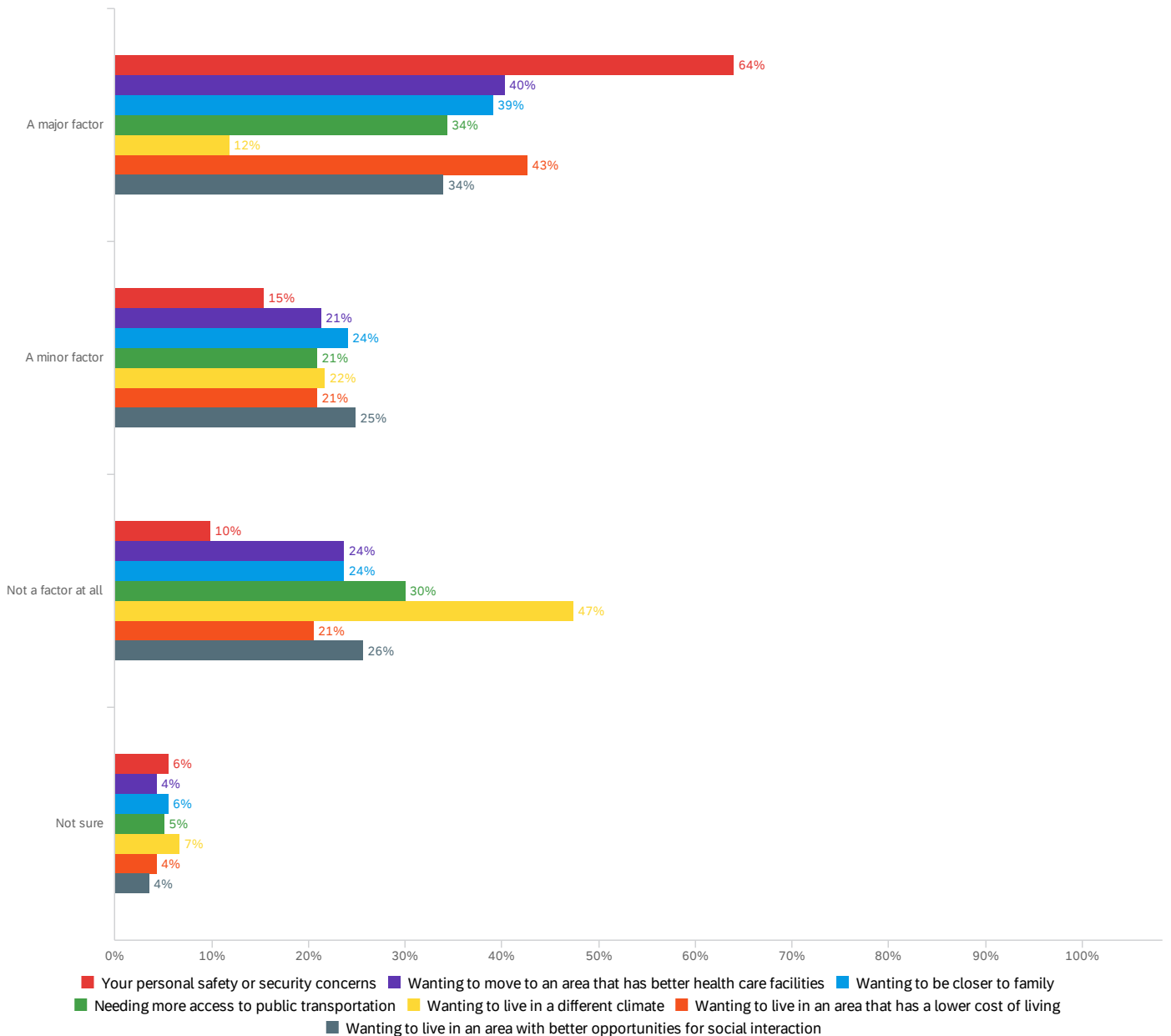

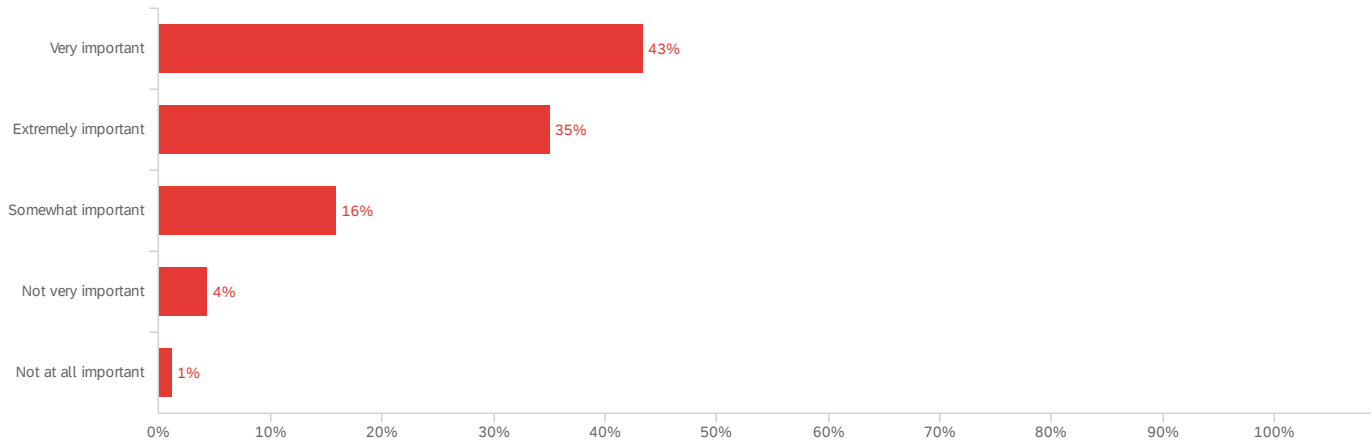

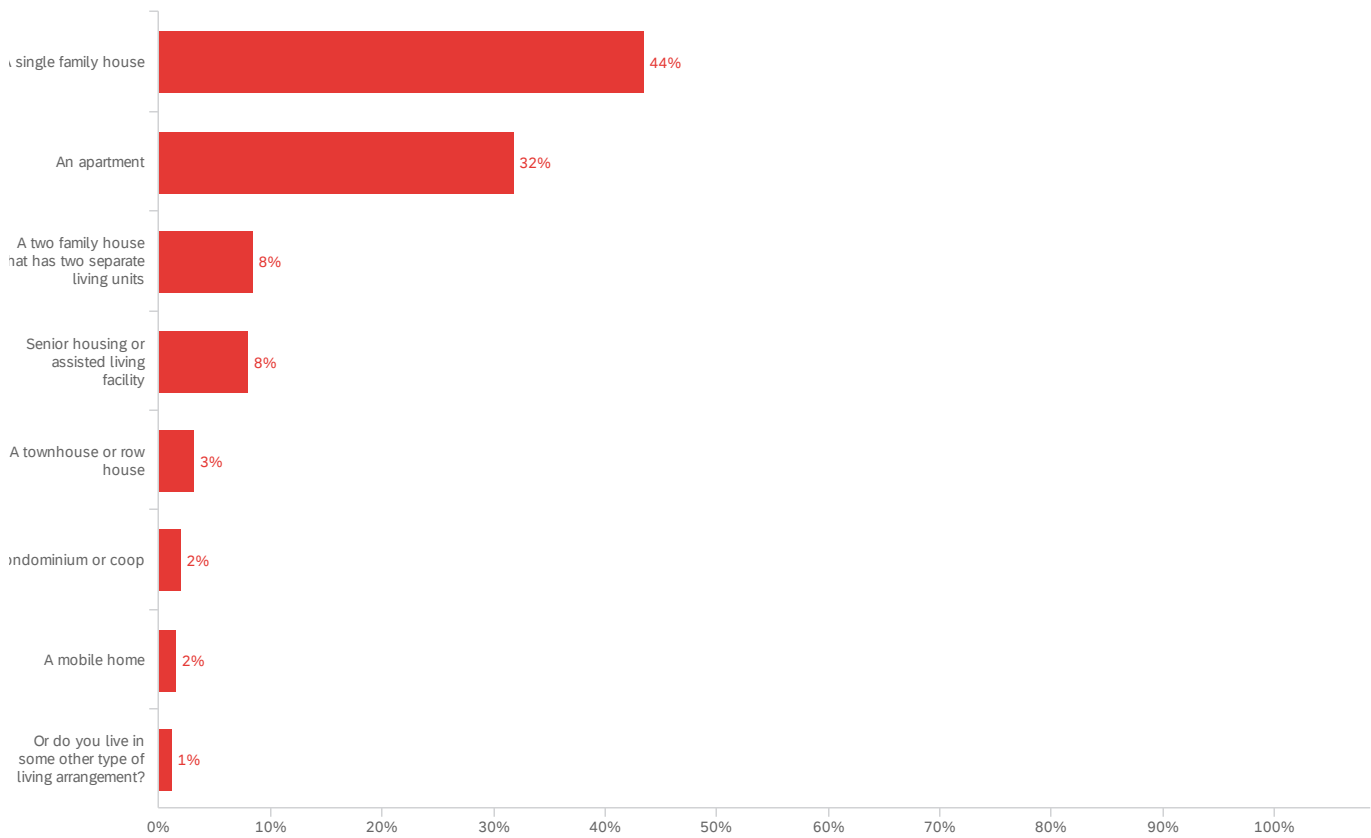
Q4.1 - How important is it for you to remain in your current community for as long as possible?

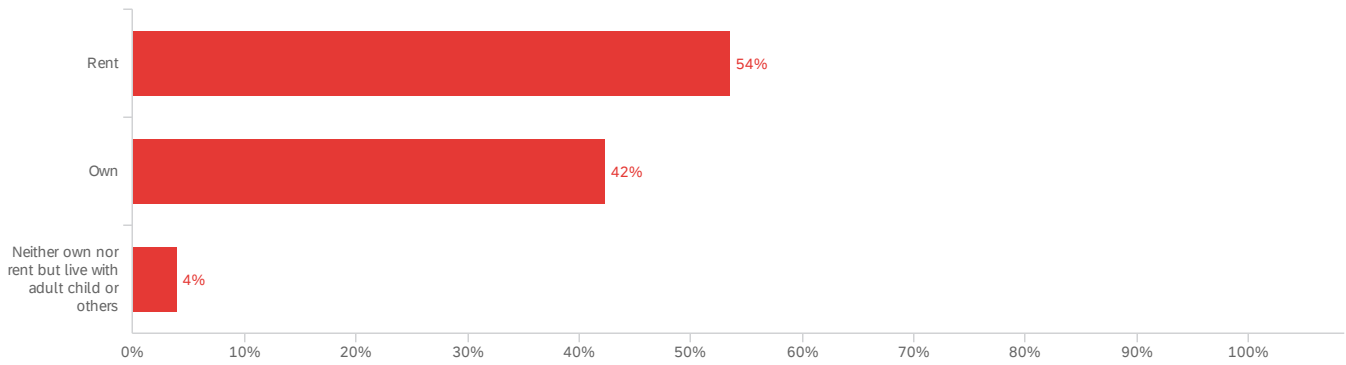

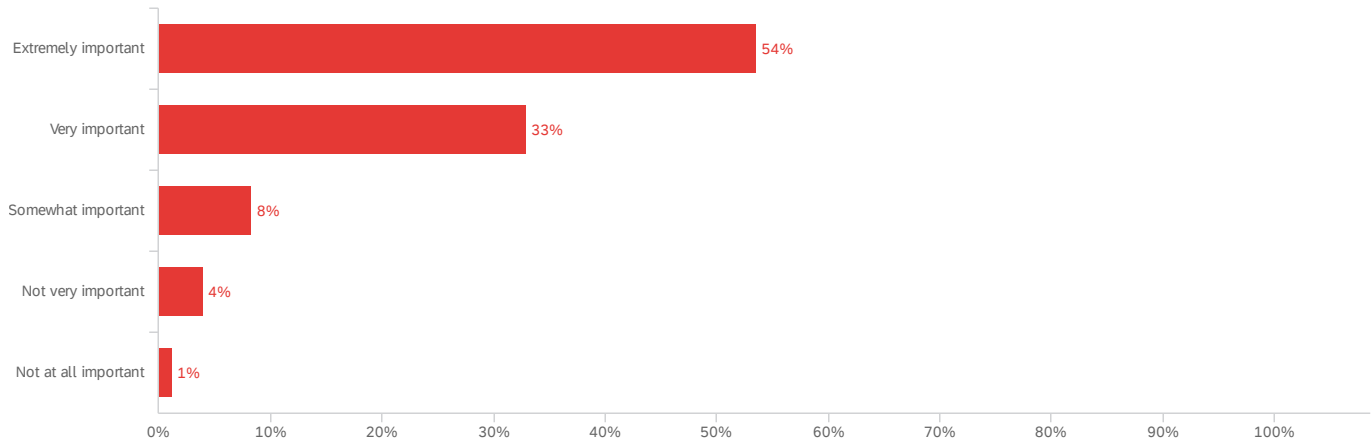
Q4.3 - Do you own or rent your residence?

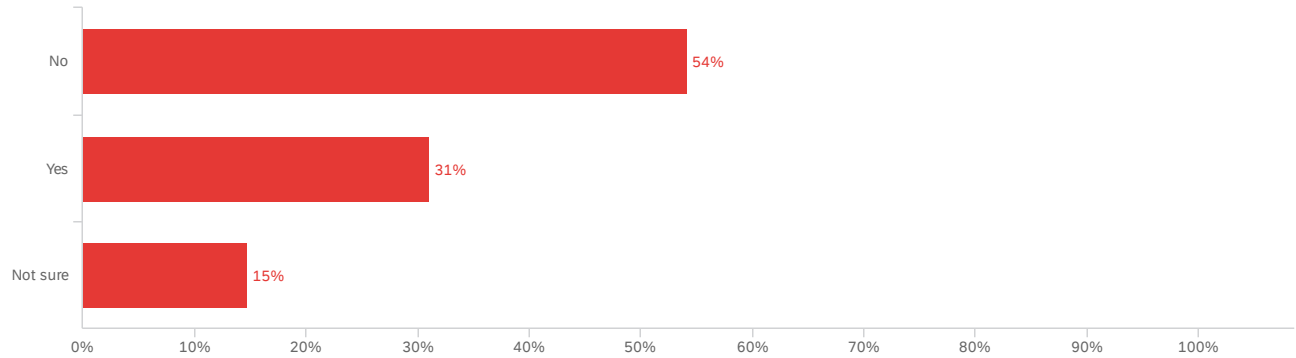
Q4.4 - How important is it for you to be able to live independently in your own home as you age?

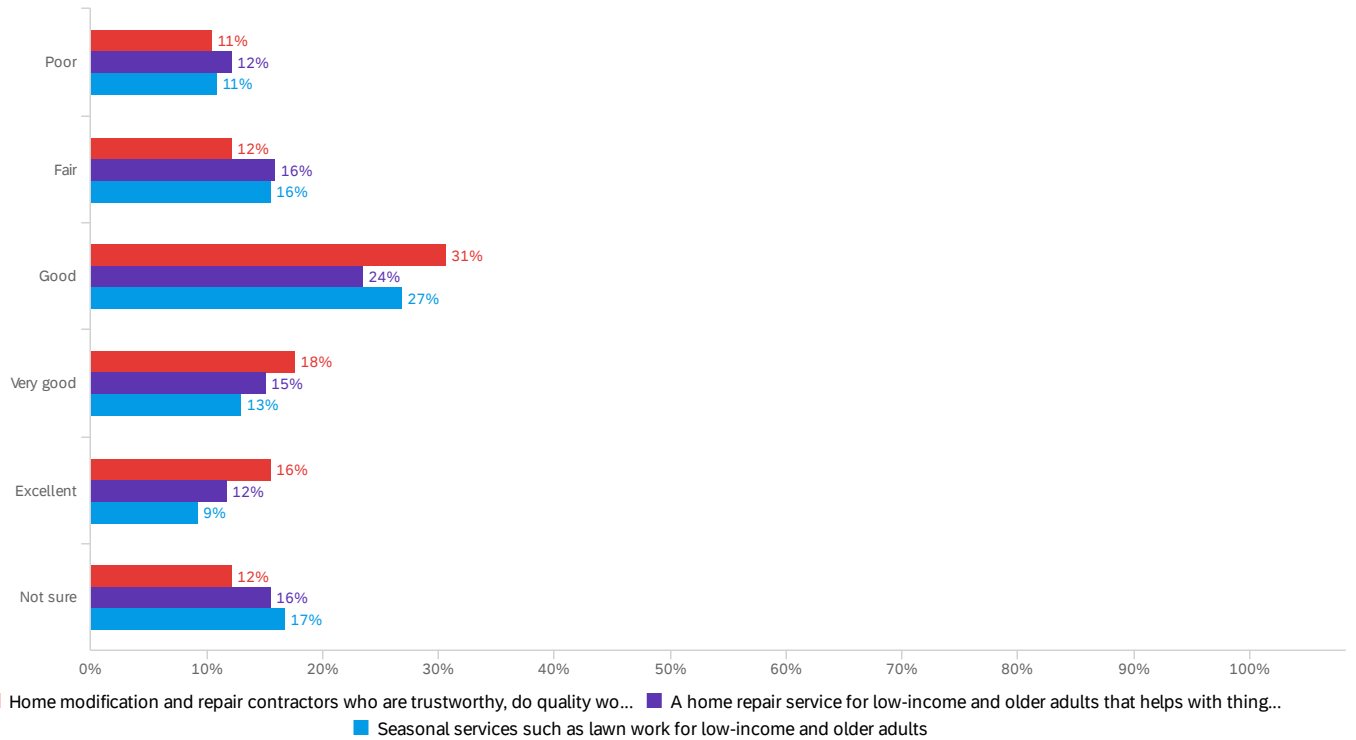

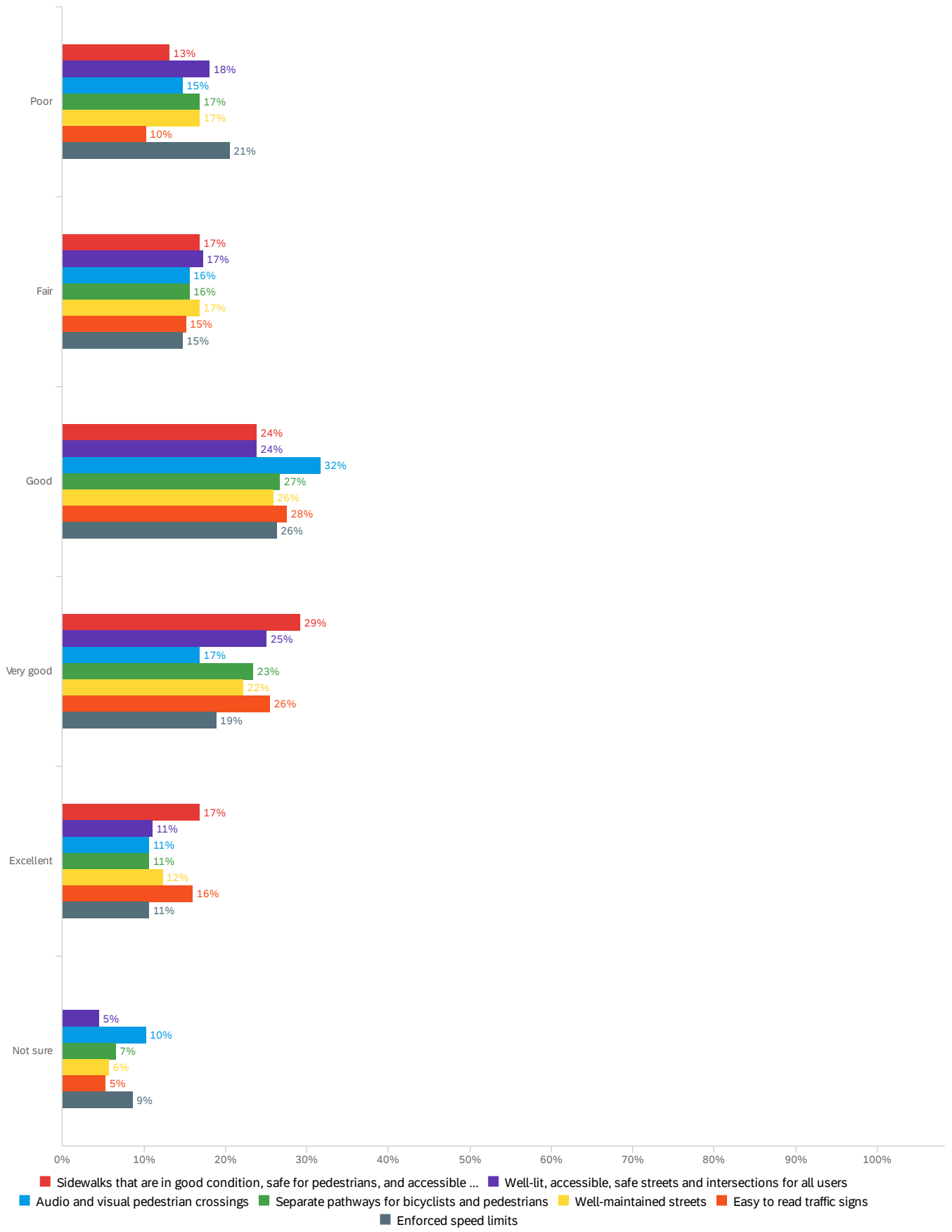

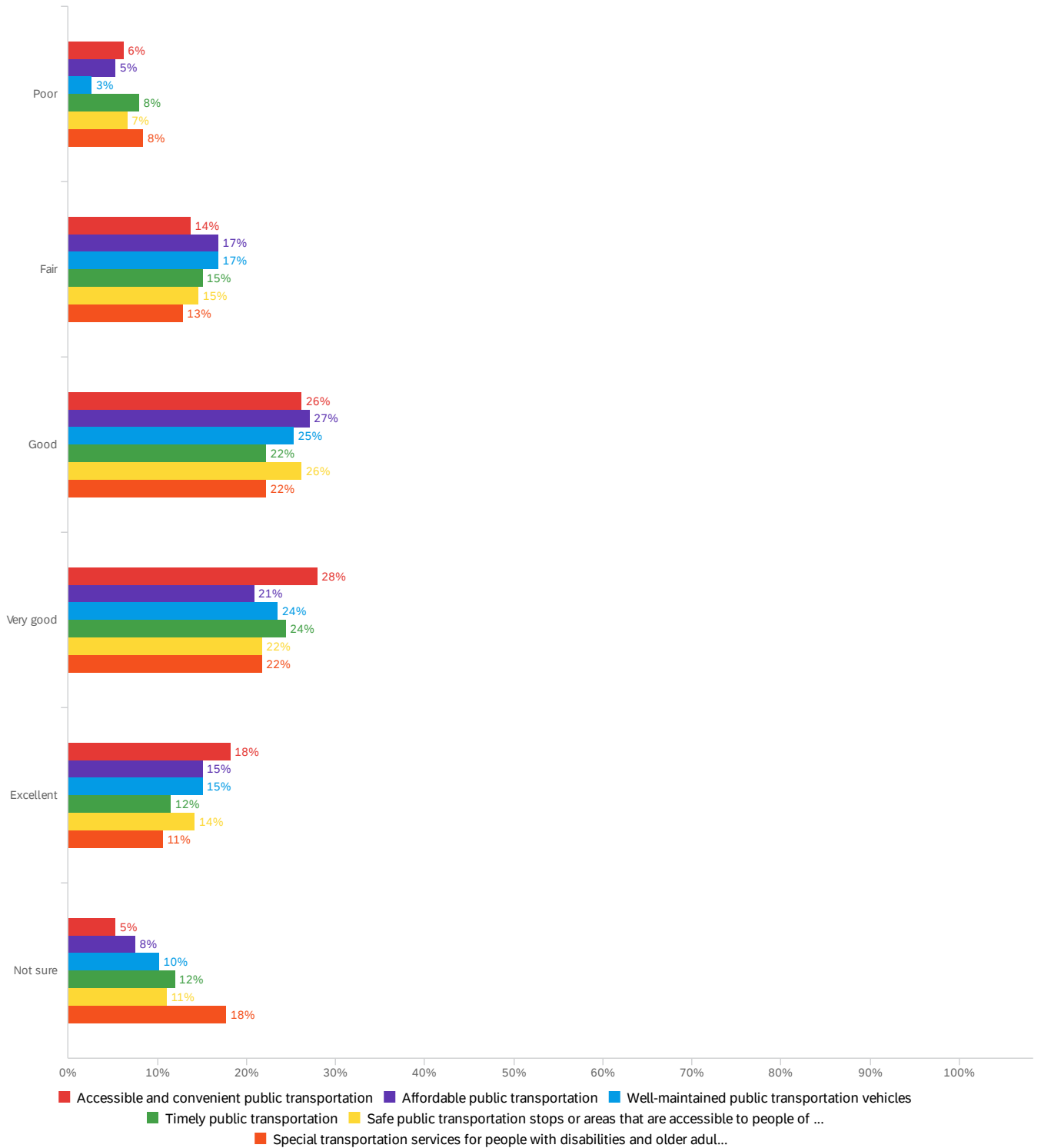

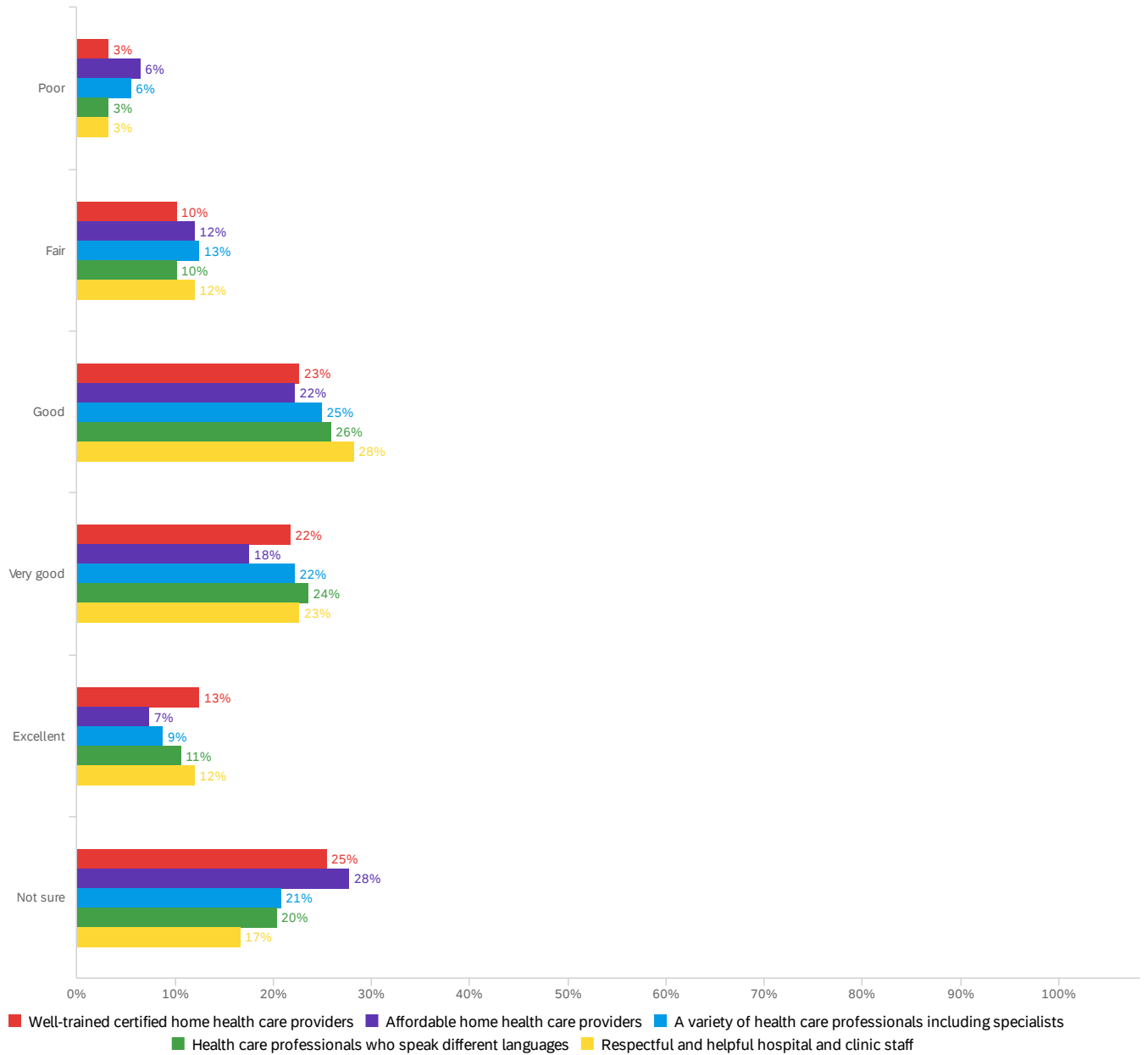

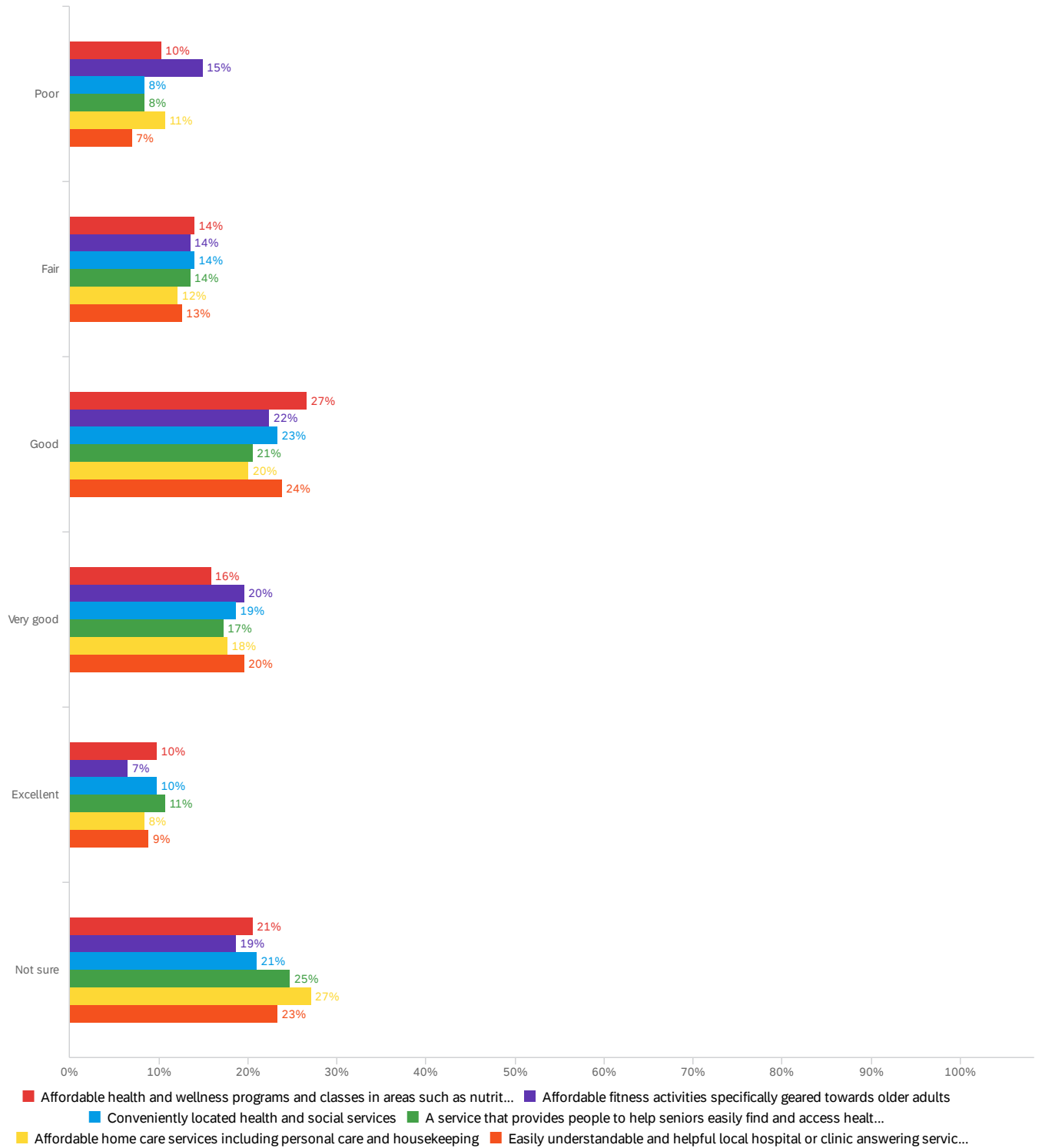

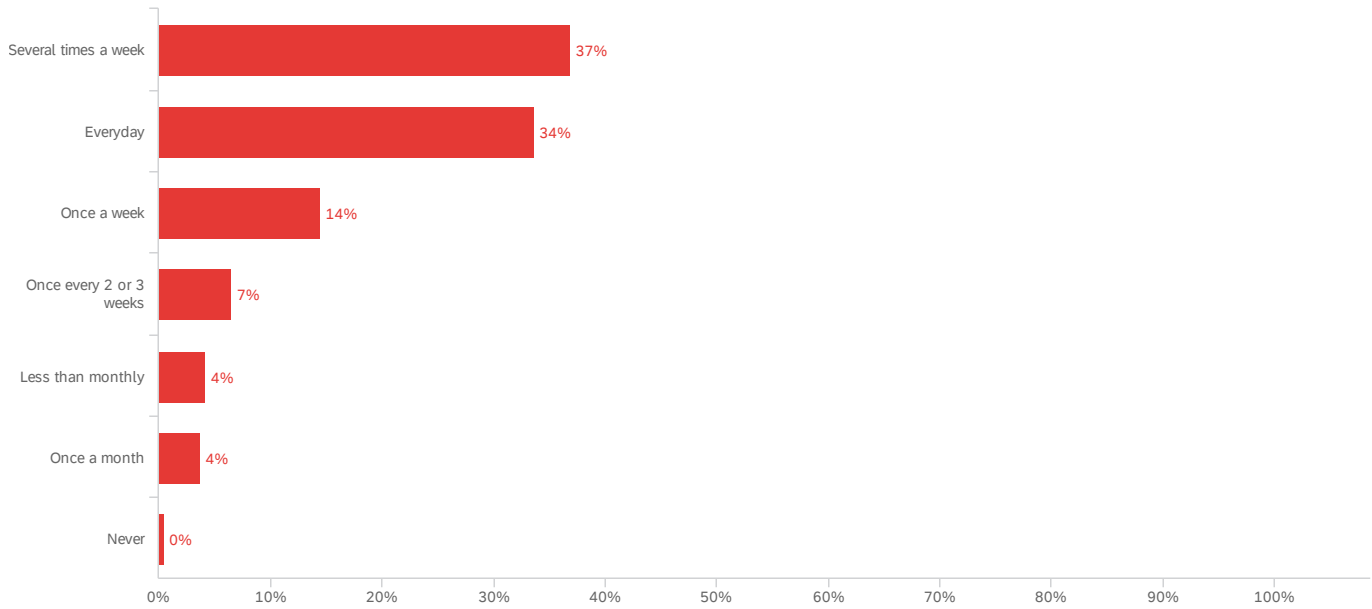

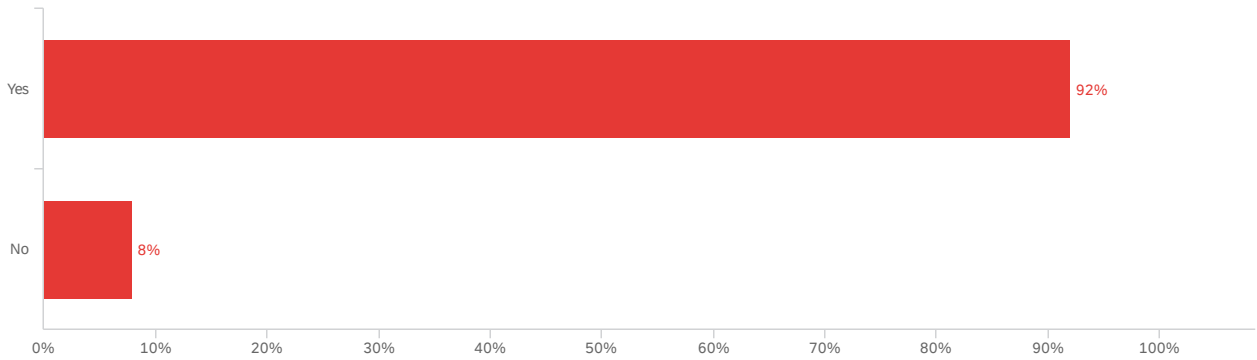

Q8.4 - If you were in trouble, do you have friends or family who can help you at any time of the day or night?

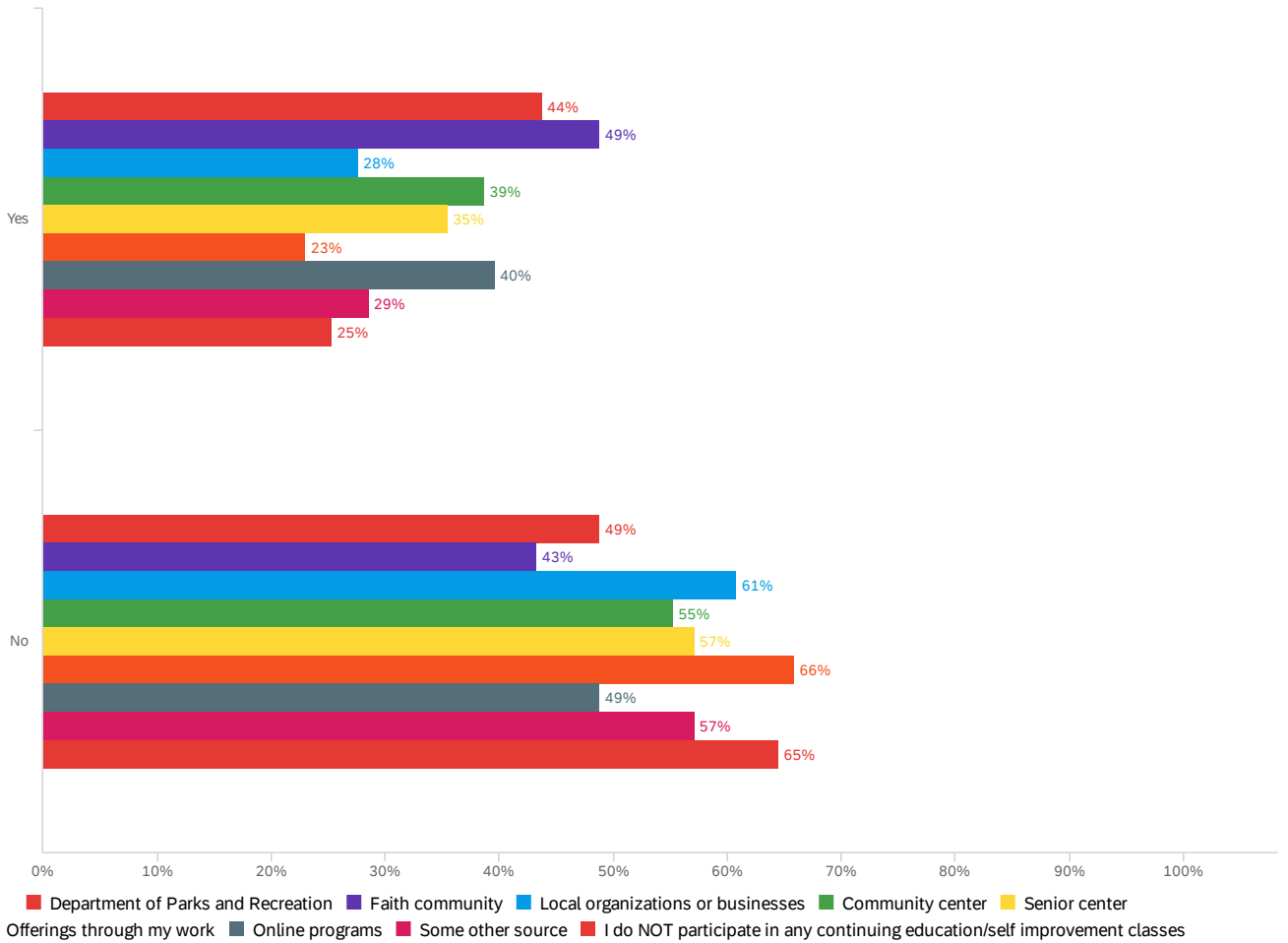

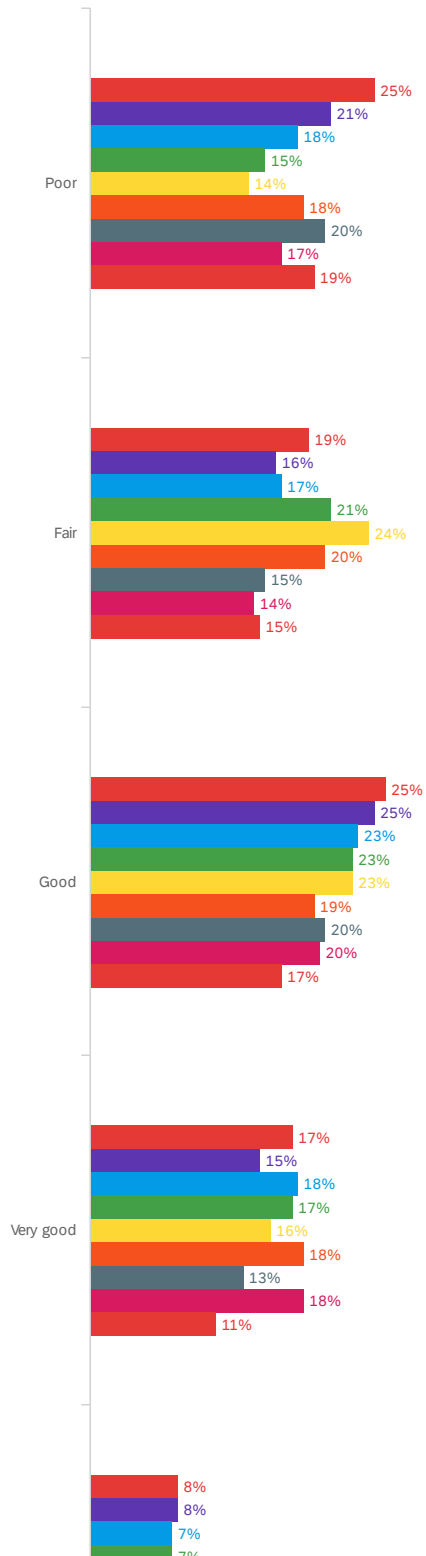
Q8.5 - Do you use the following sources for continuing education or self-improvement classes or workshops in your community?

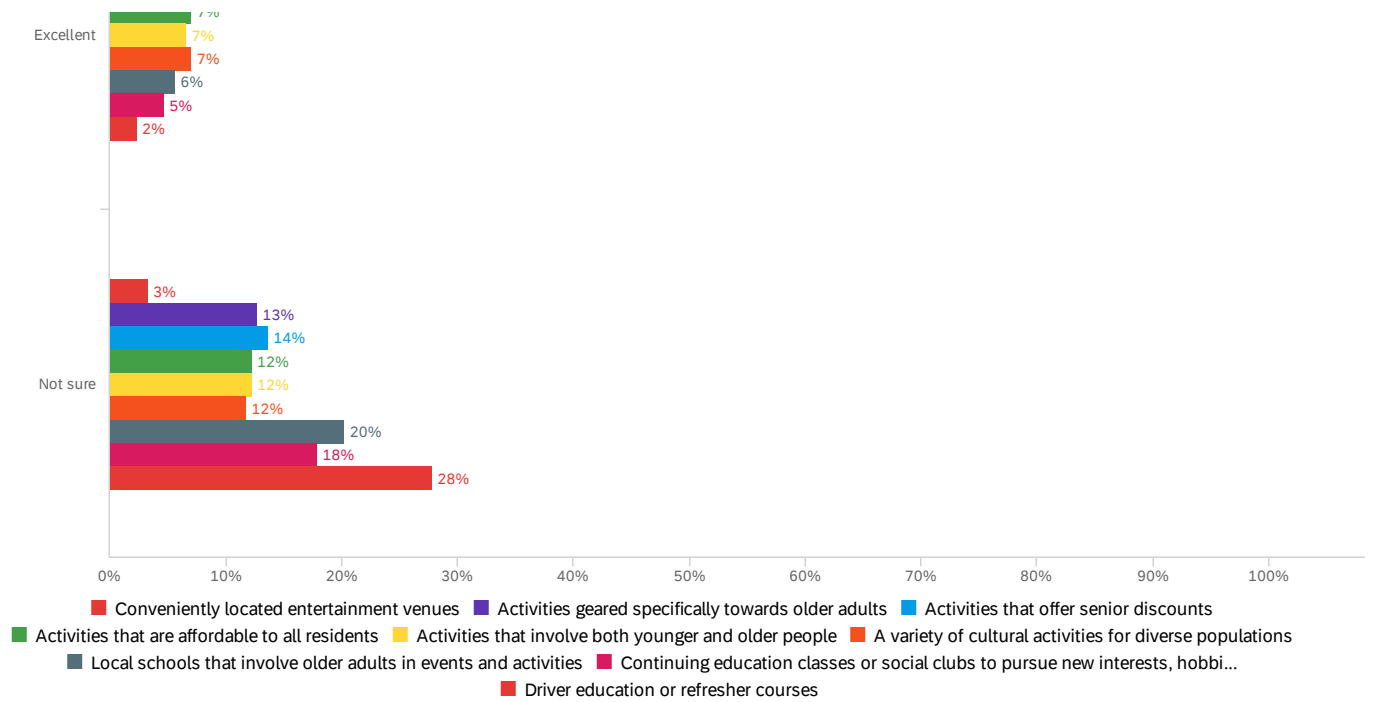

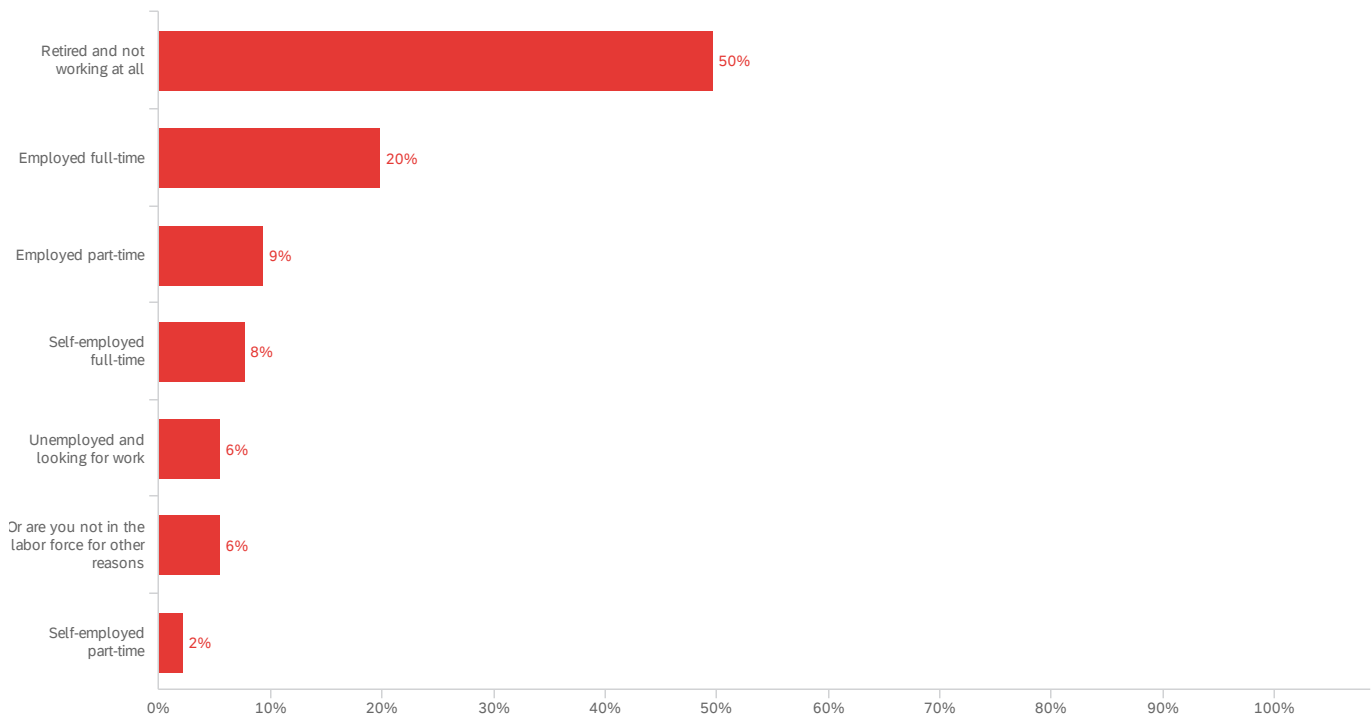

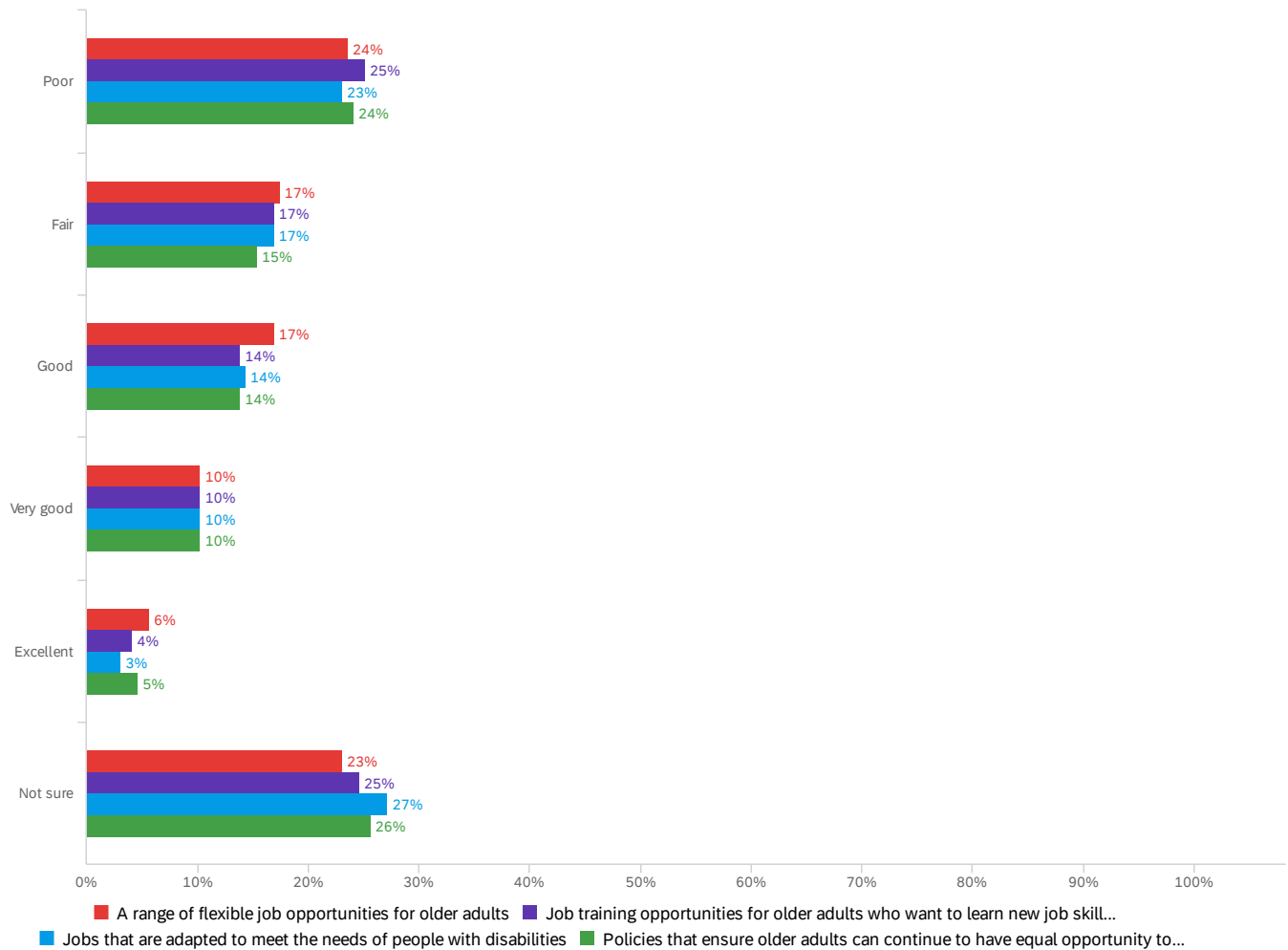
Q10.3 - How likely is it that you will continue to work as long as possible, rather than choosing to retire and no longer work for pay?

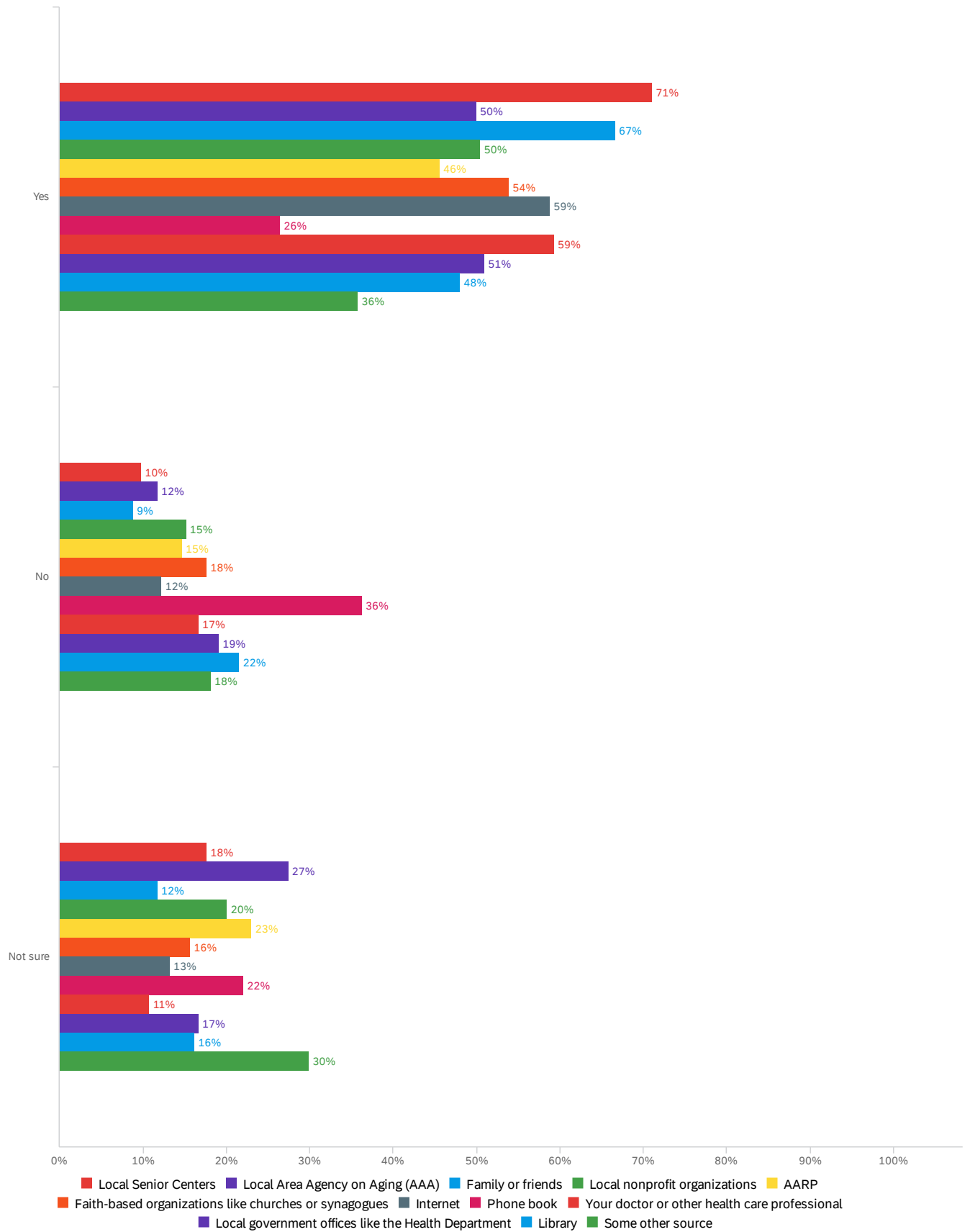

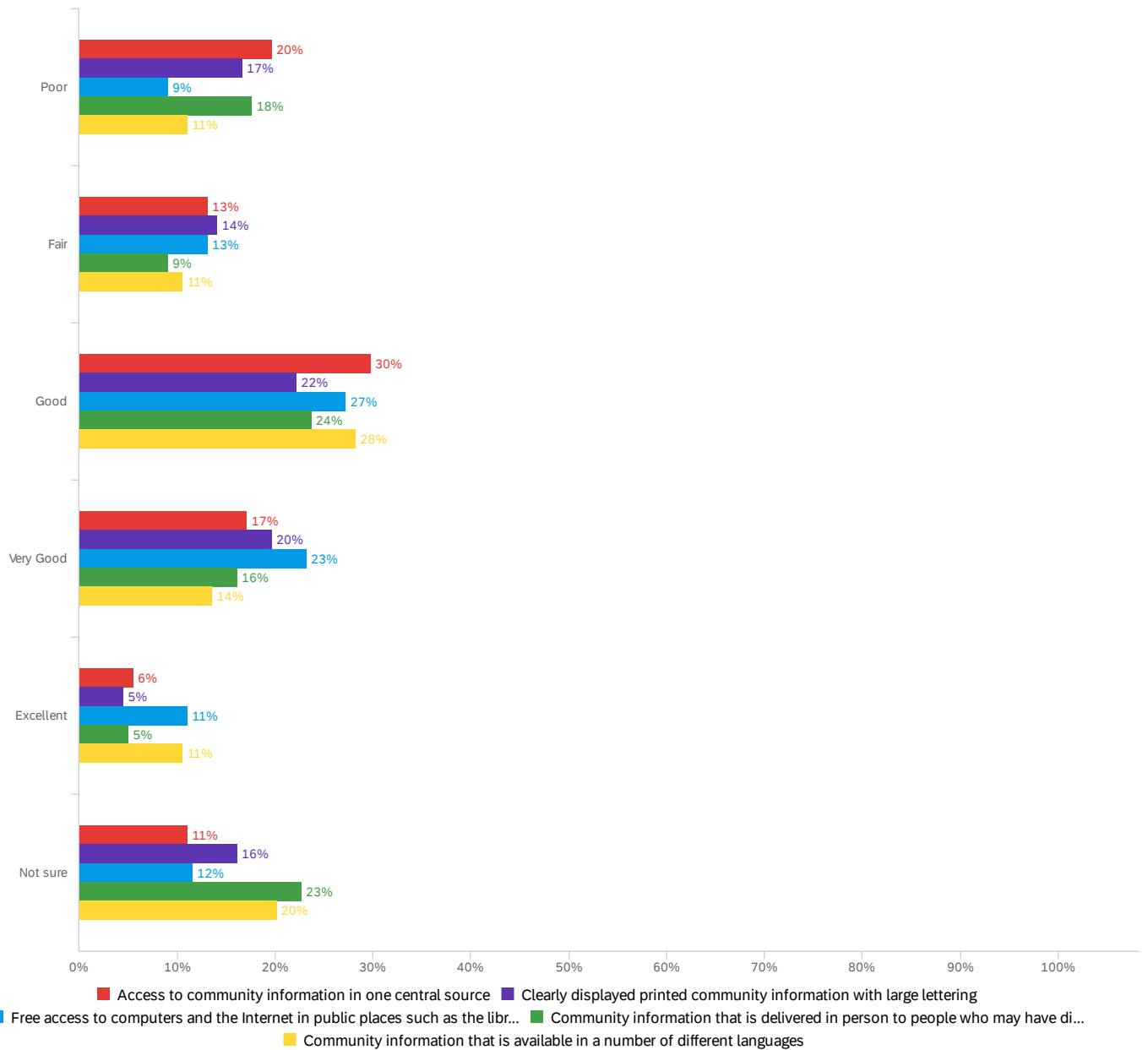

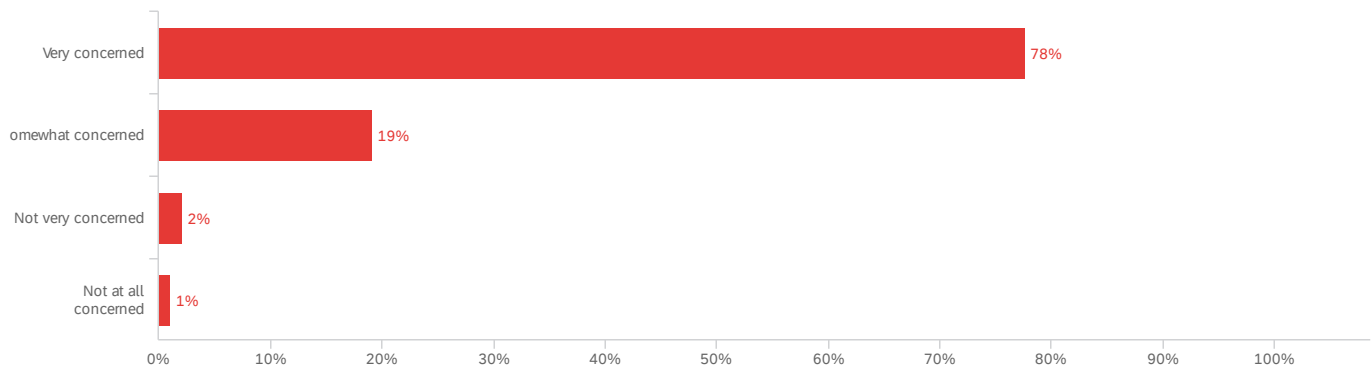

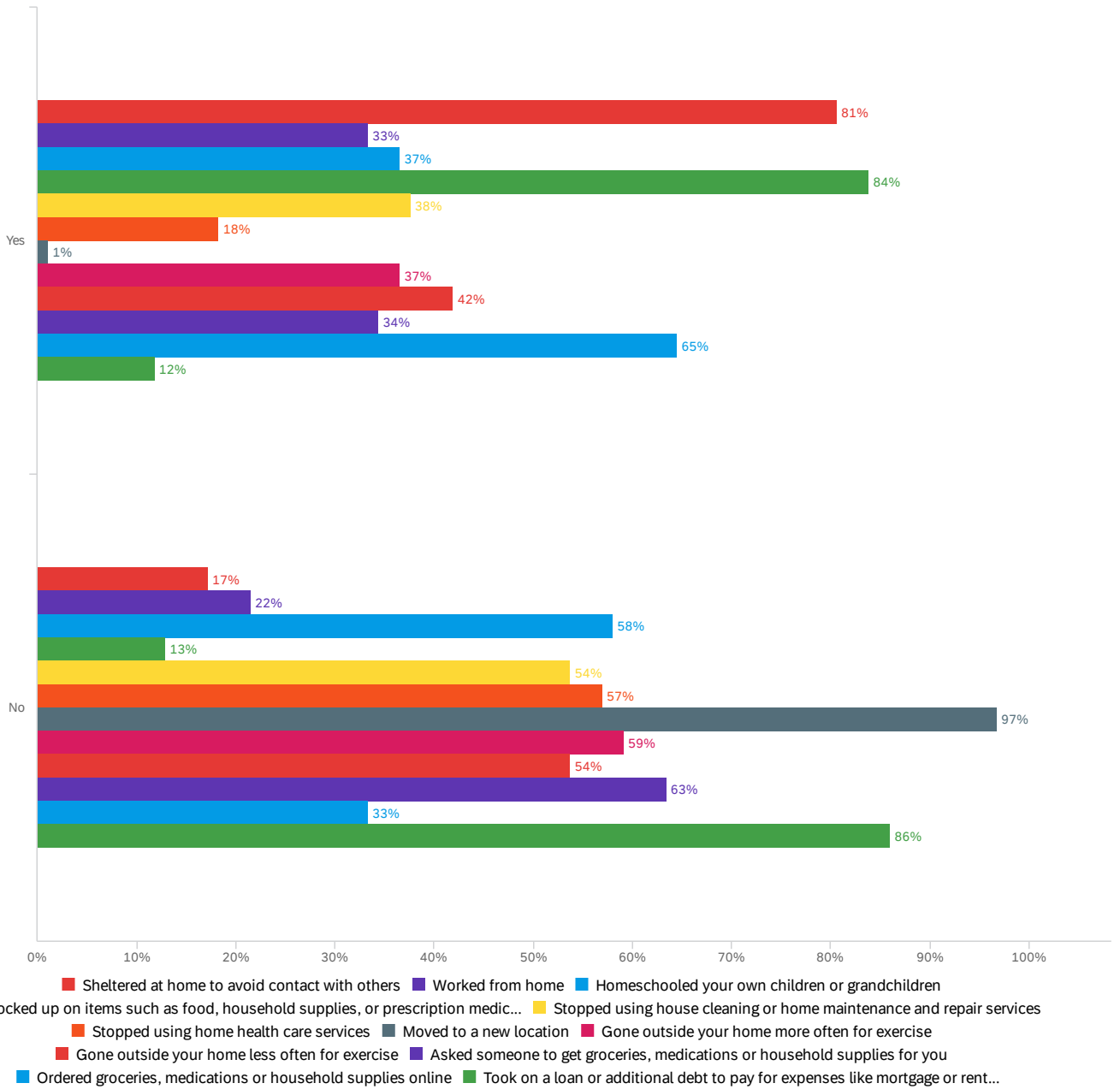

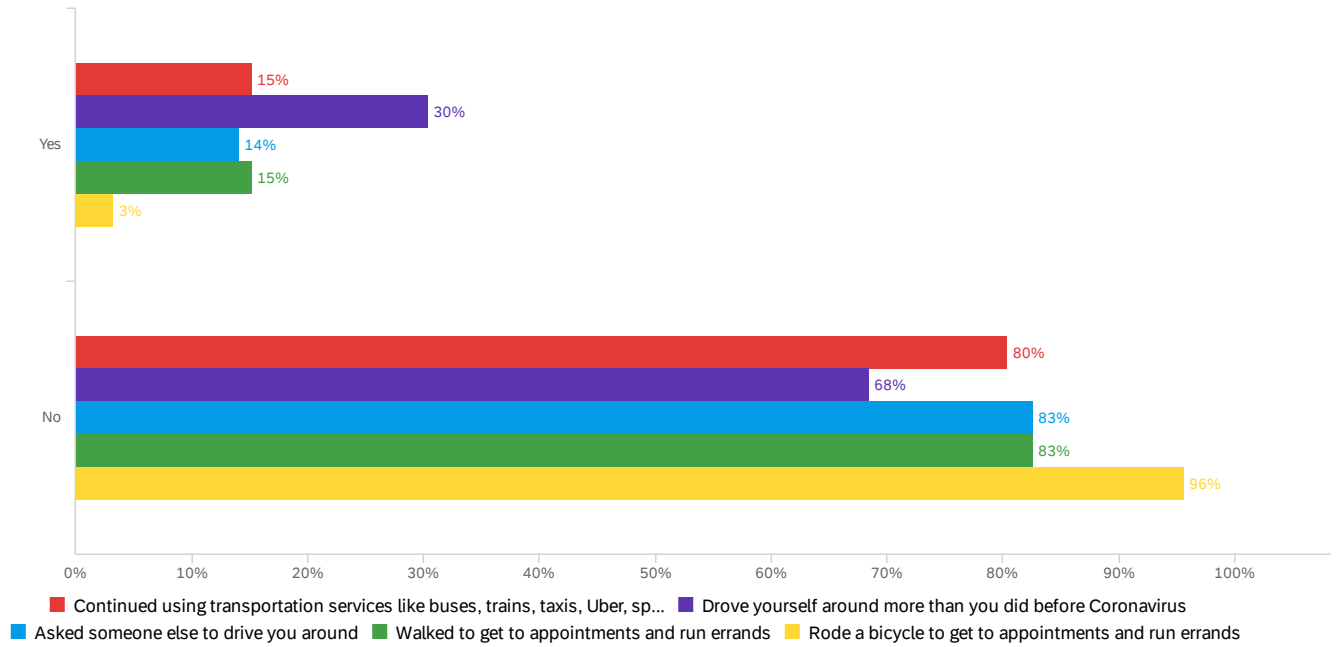

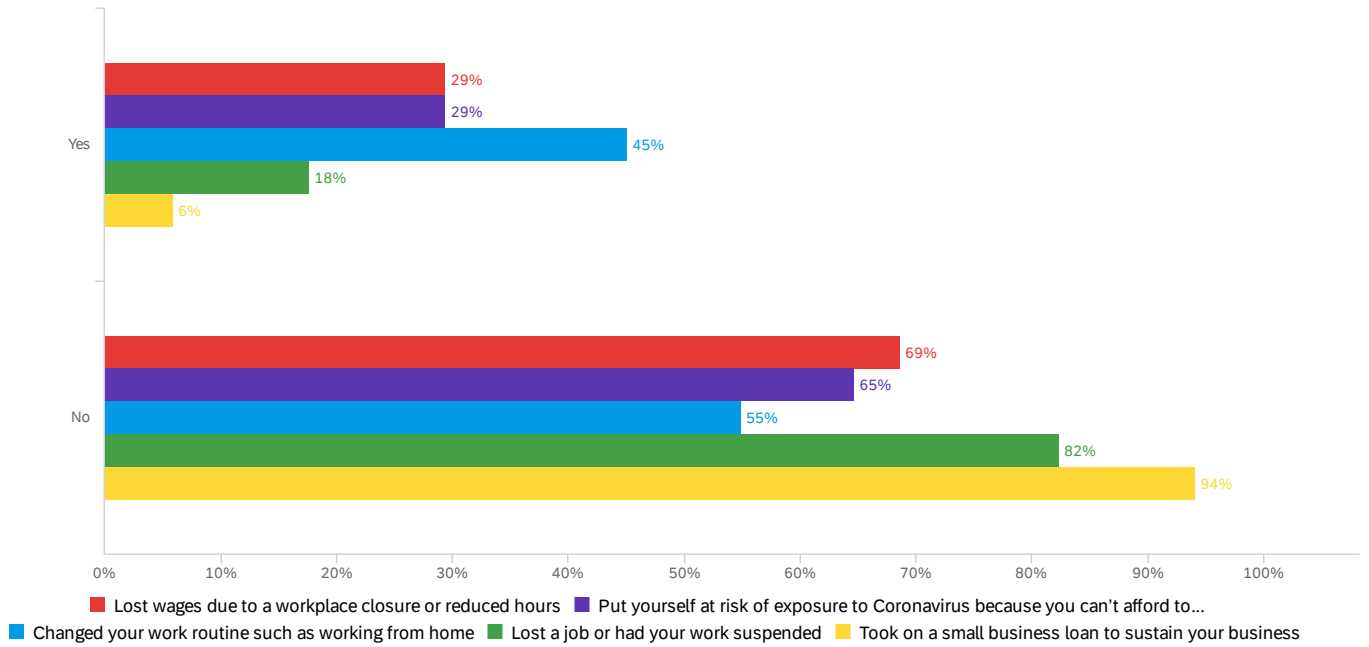

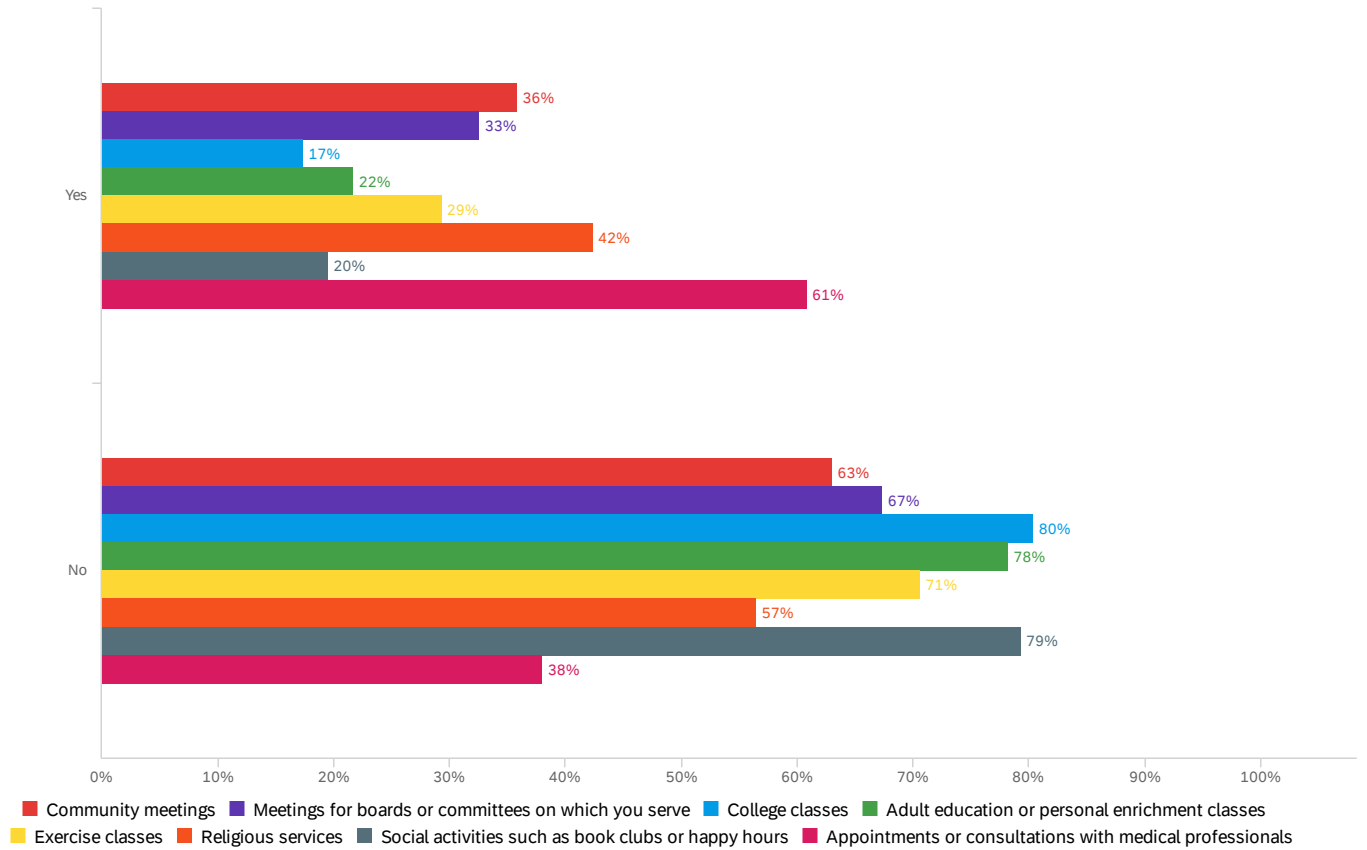

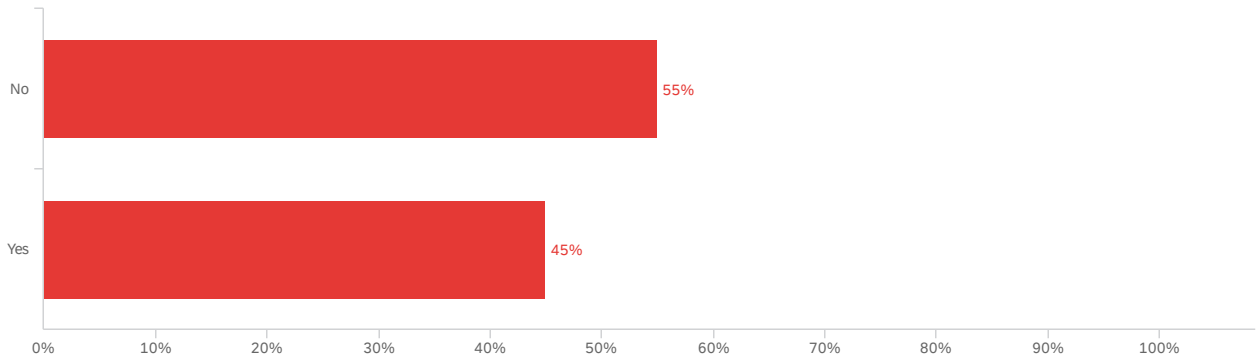

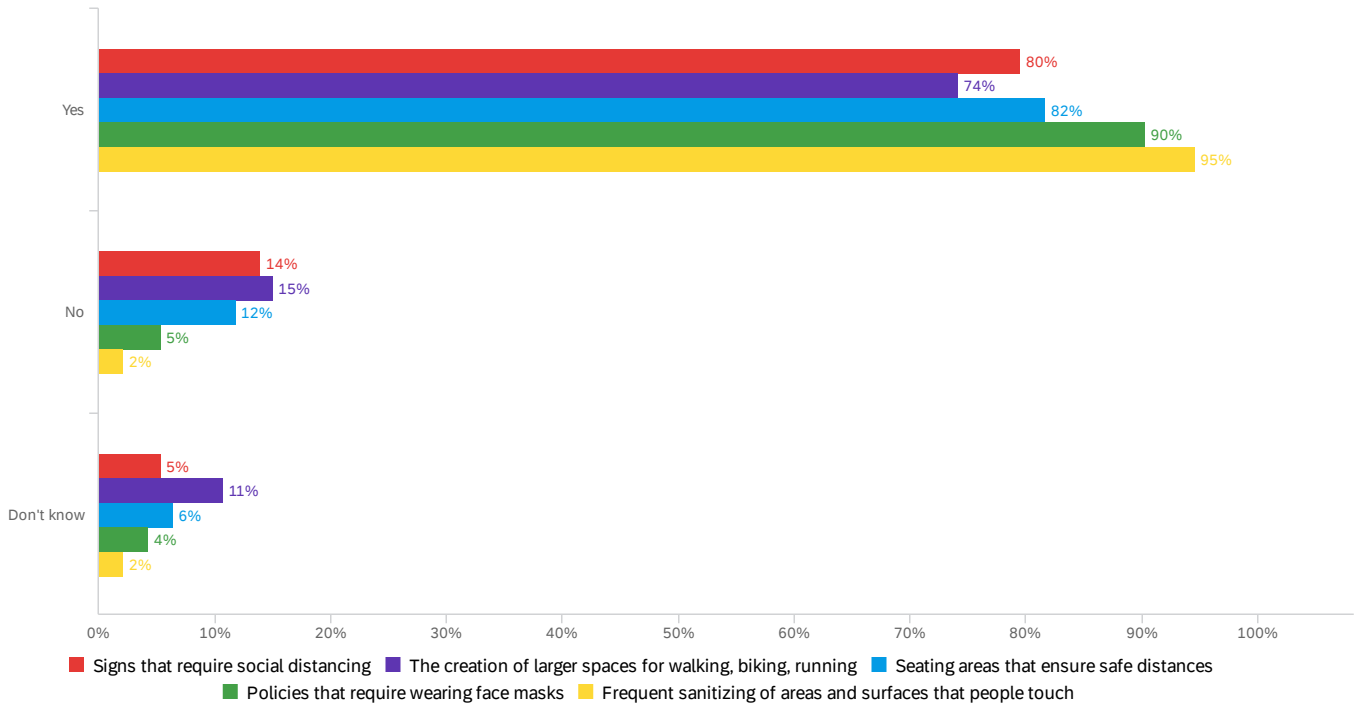

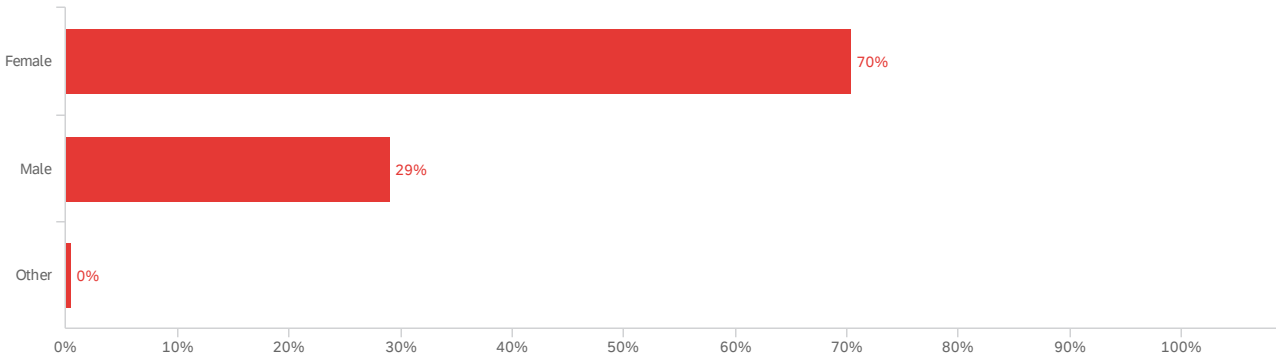

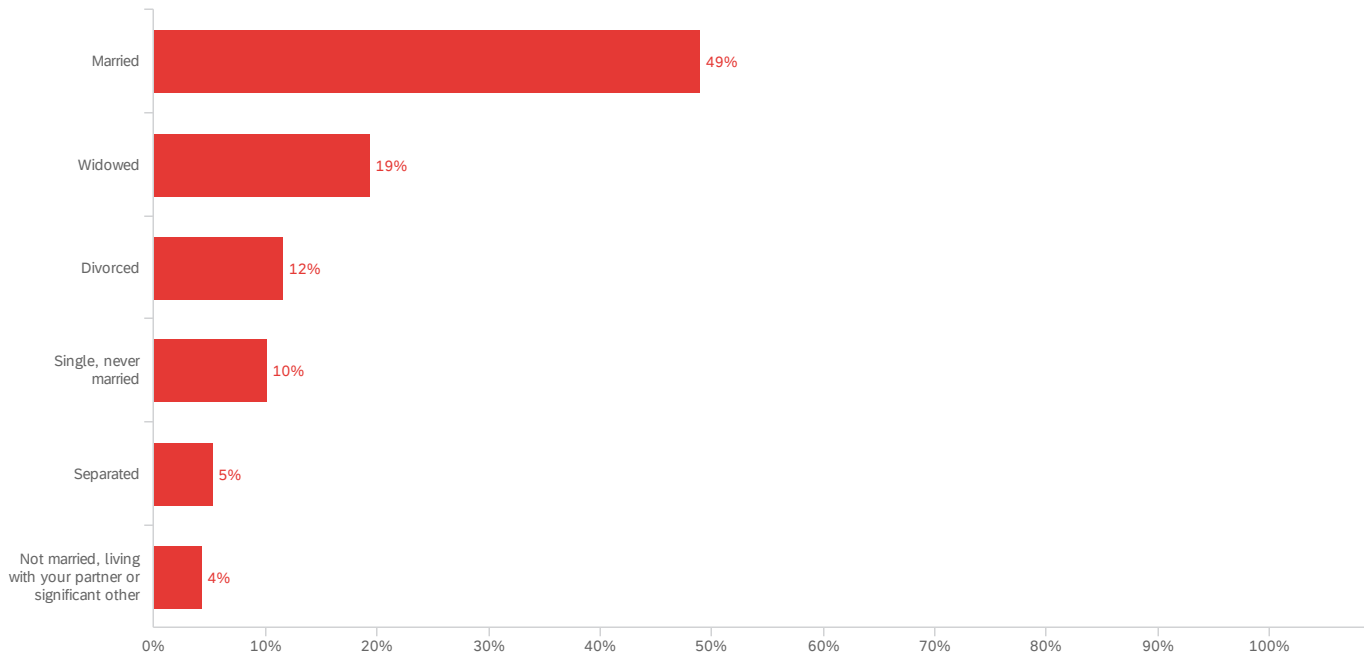
Q12.2 - What is your gender?

Q13.1 - What is your current marital status?

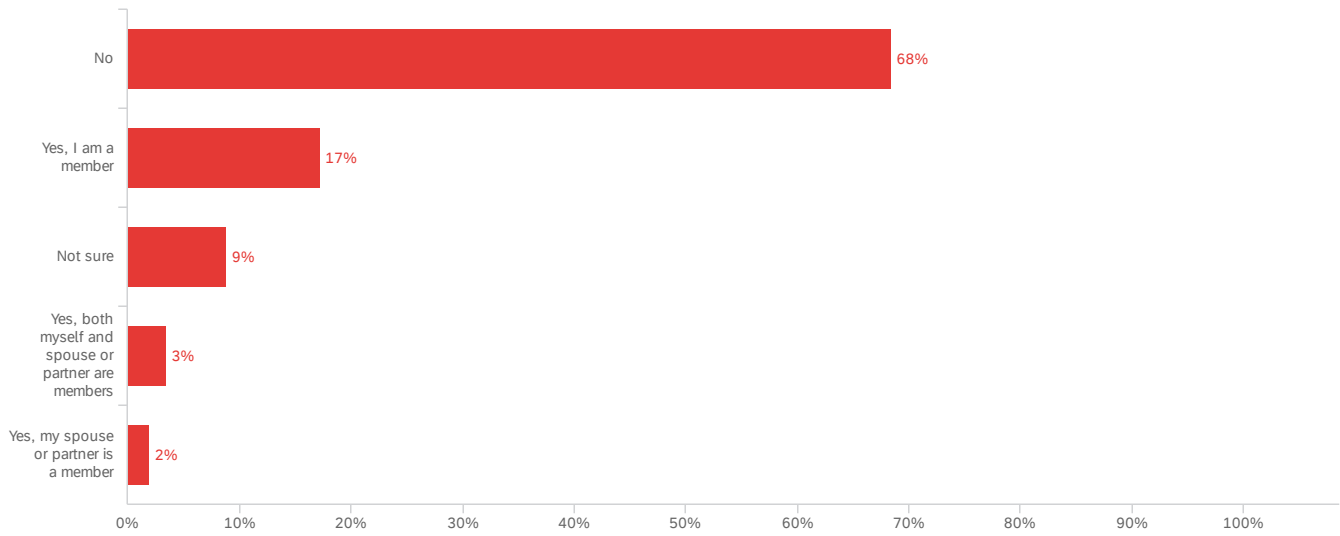

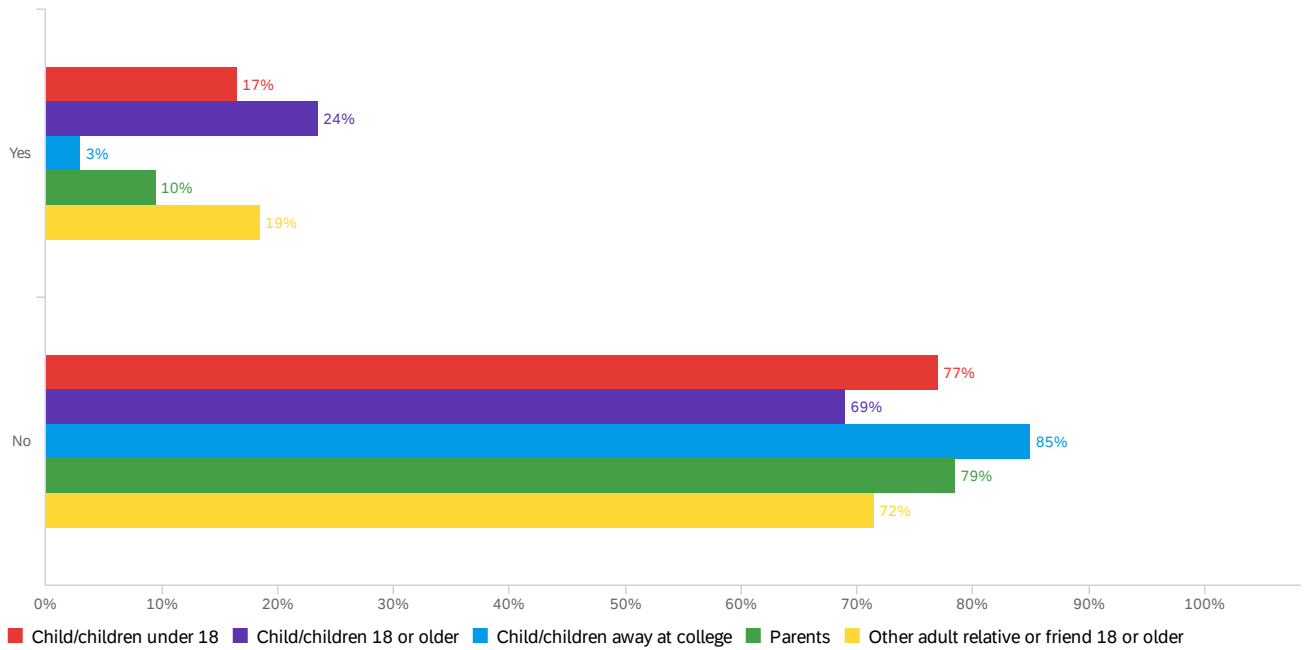
Q13.2 - Are you, your spouse or partner currently a member of AARP?

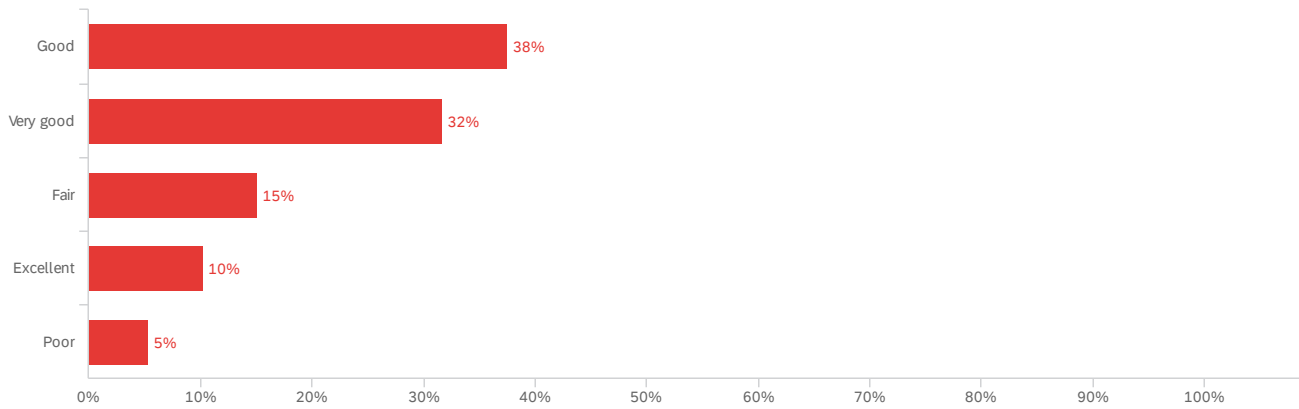

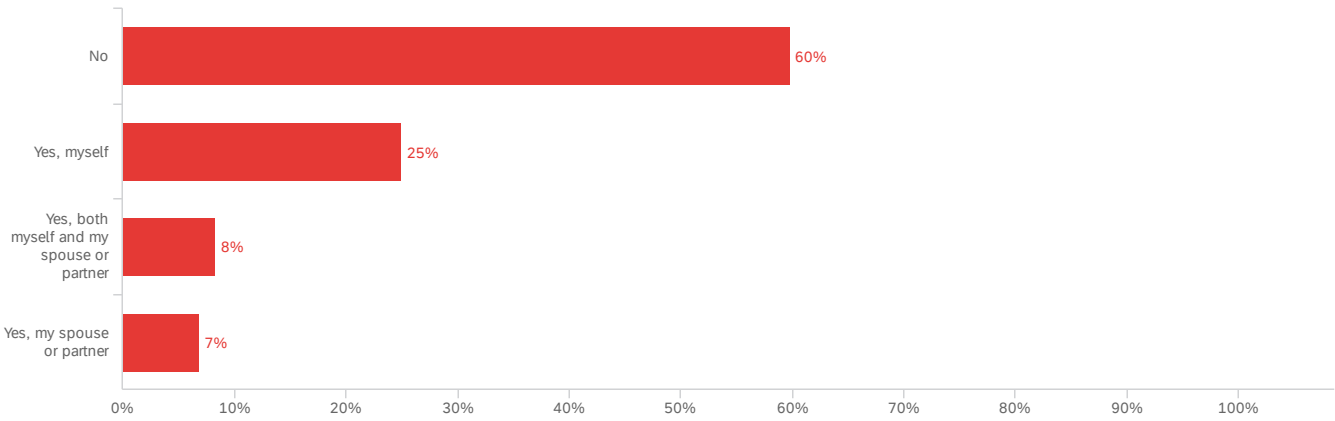
Q14.2 - In general would you say your health is:?

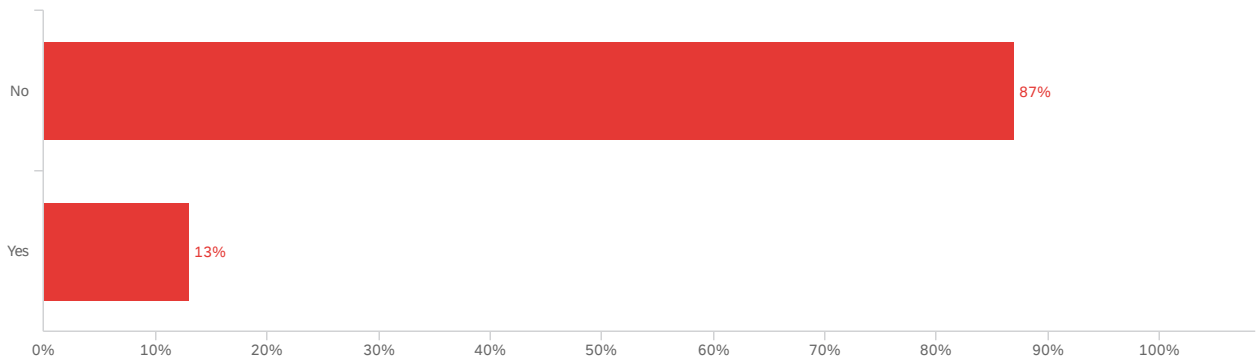
Q15.1 - Does any disability, handicap, or chronic disease keep you, your spouse or partner from participating fully in work, school, housework, or other activities?

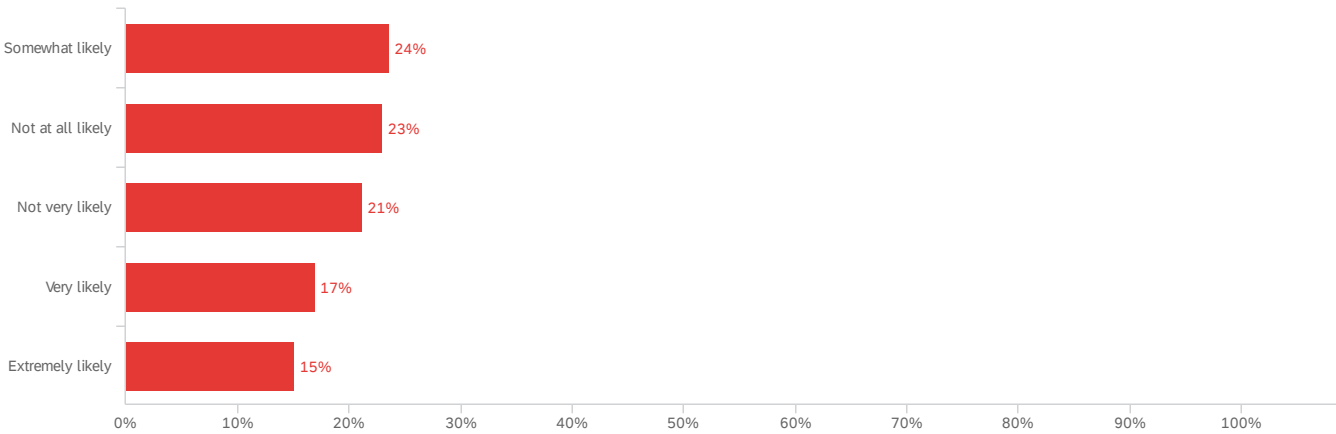

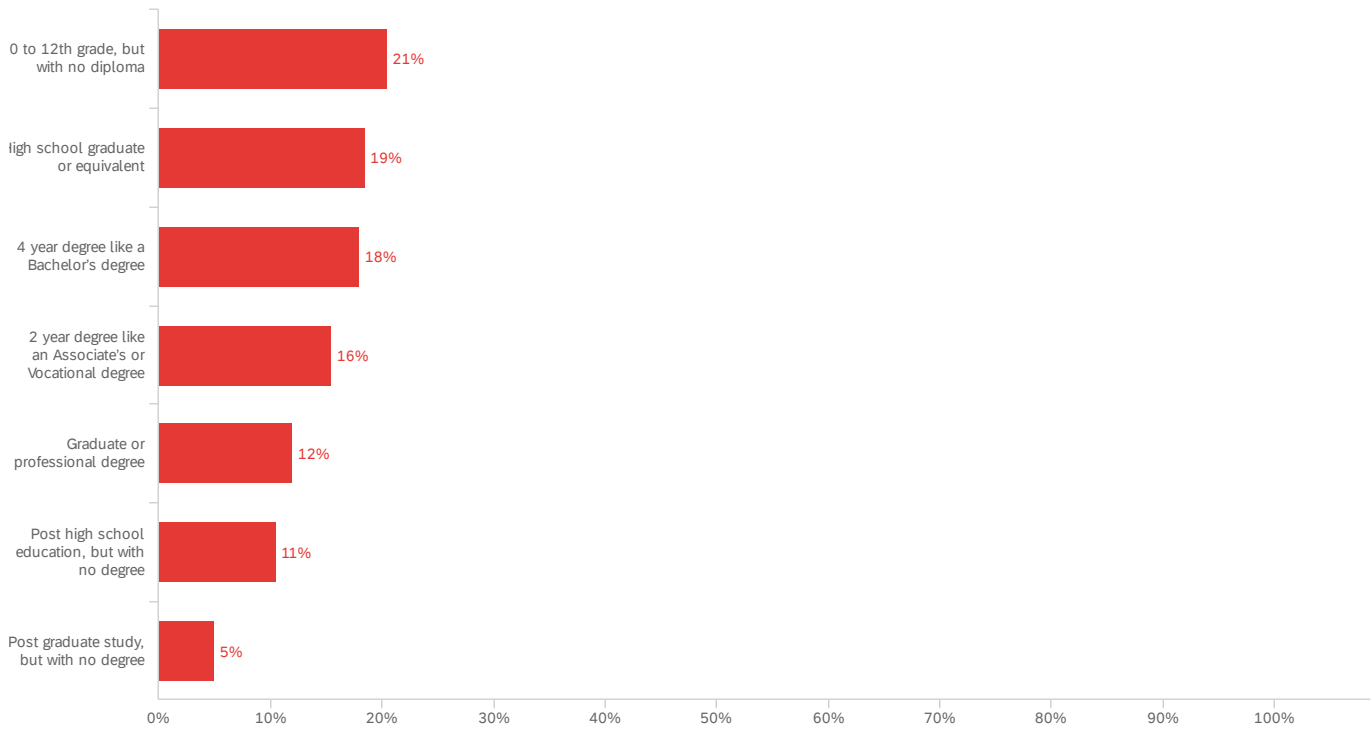
Q16.2 - How likely is it that you will provide unpaid care to an adult loved one in the future?

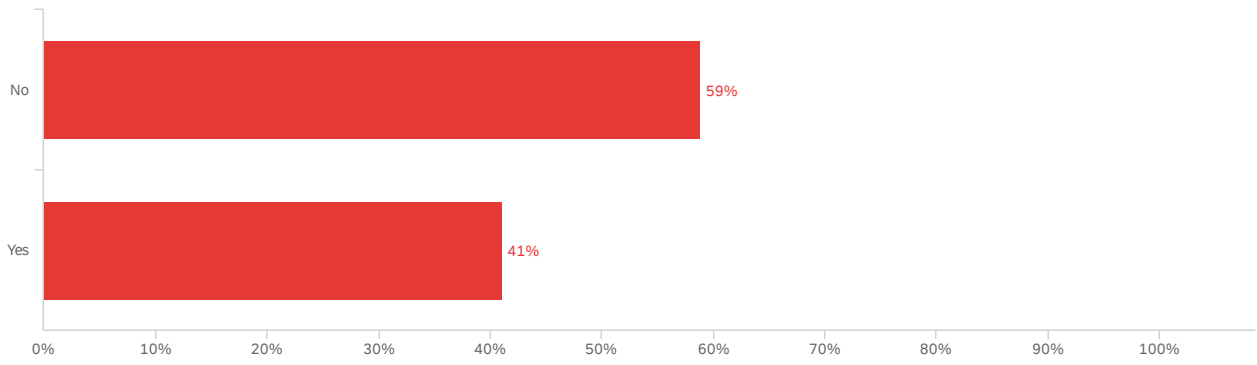
Q16.3 - What is the highest level of education that you completed?

Q16.4 - Are you of Hispanic, Spanish, or Latino origin or descent?

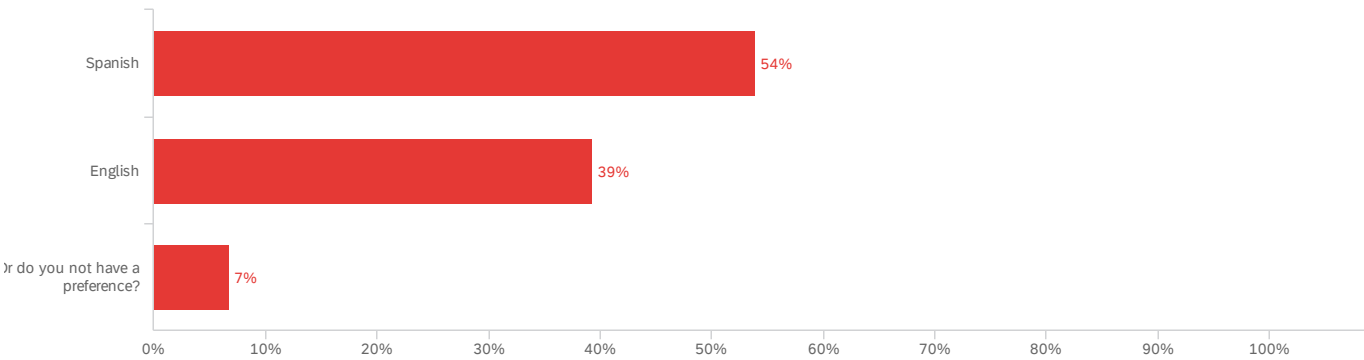

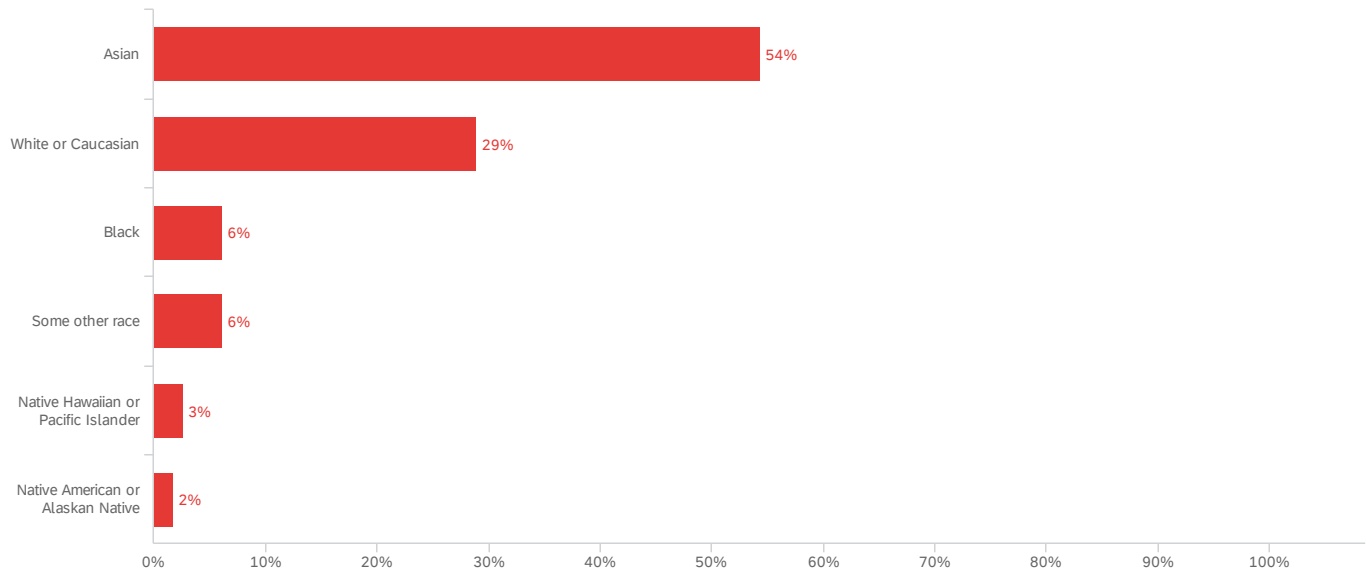
Q16.5 - Which language do you prefer to speak?

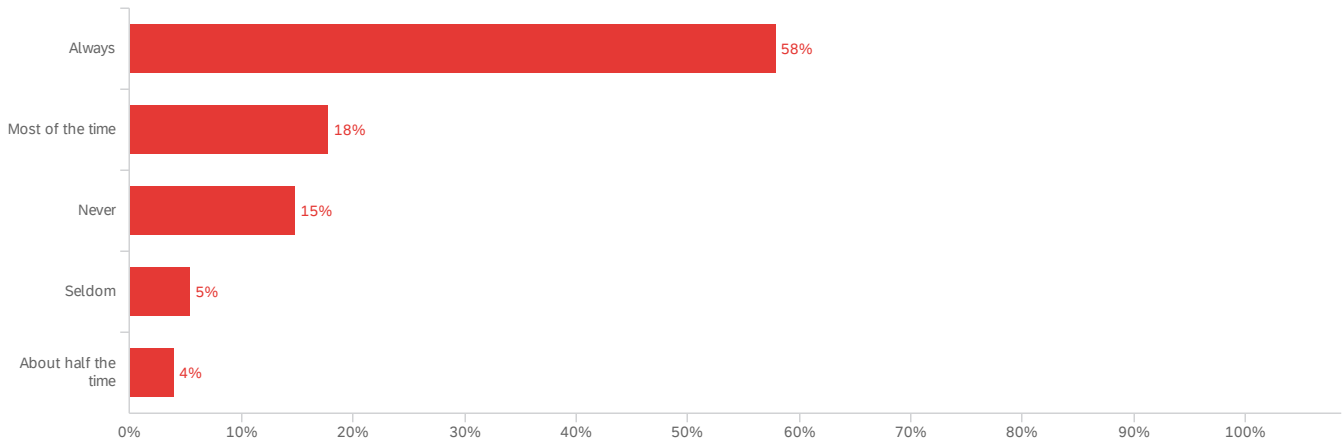
Q16.6 - What race do you consider yourself?

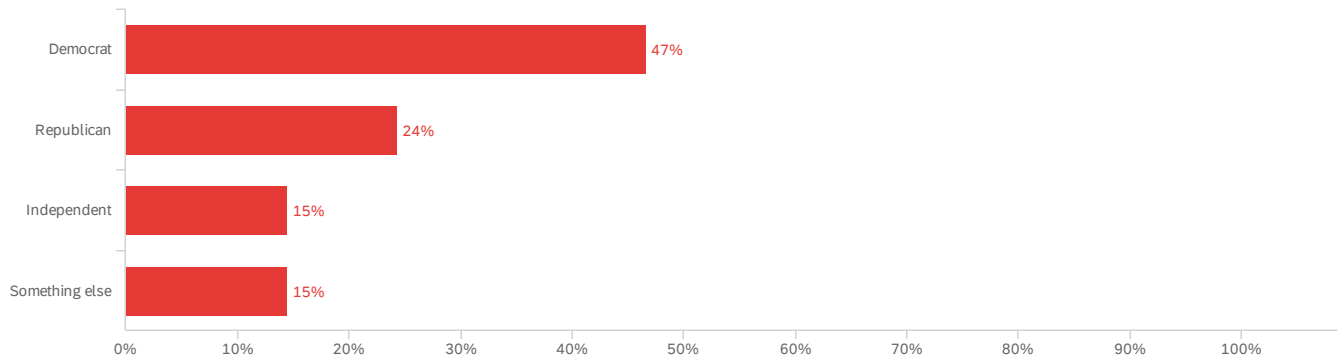
Q16.7 - Thinking about your state elections for Governor and Legislators in the last 10 years, which of the following best describes your voting behavior? How often would you say you vote?

Q16.8 - Which political party do you most identify with?

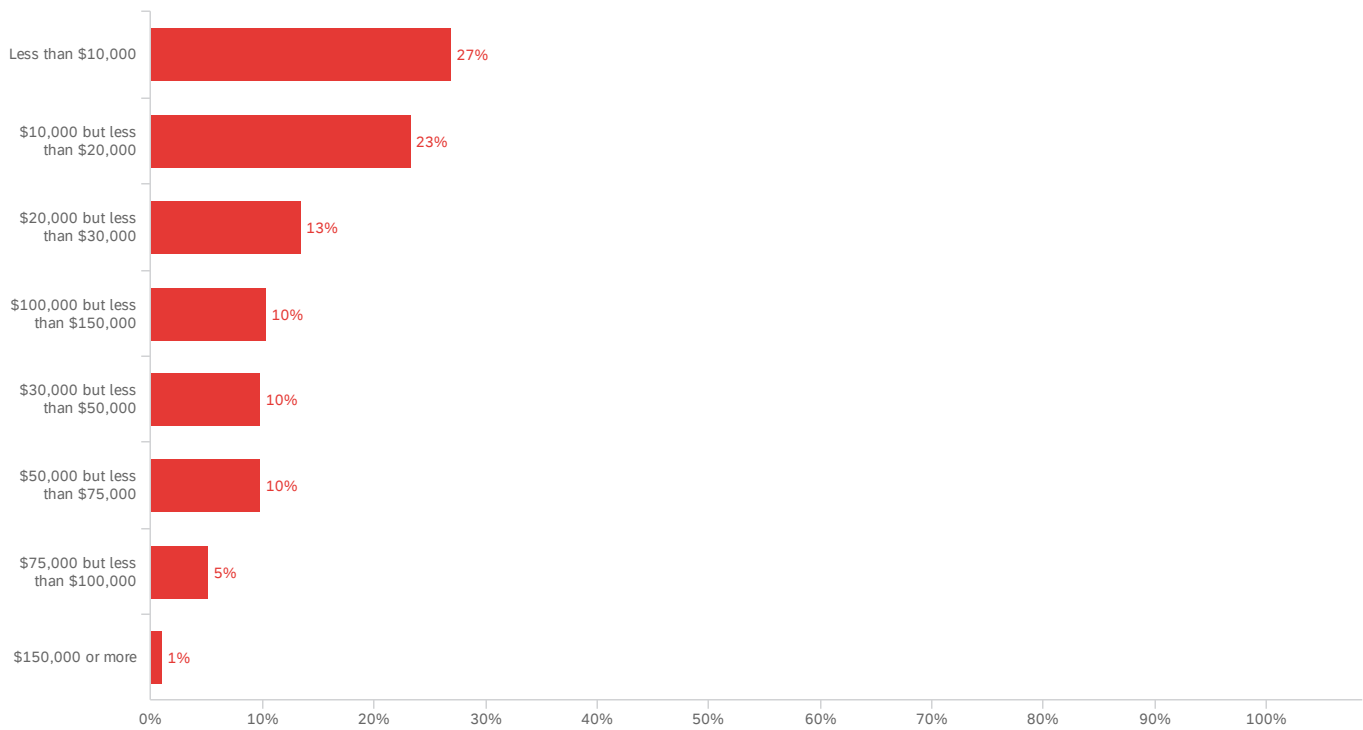
