### **SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE ADOPTING A MILITARY USE POLICY**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** at their regular meeting held March 1, 2022, the City Council of the City of National City introduced a proposed ordinance for first reading, which, if adopted, adds a Military Use Policy to the City of National City, California, Municipal Code.

Assembly Bill 481, codified at California Government Code sections 7070 through 7075, requires law enforcement agencies to obtain approval of the applicable governing body, by an ordinance adopting a “military equipment” use policy, at a regular meeting held pursuant to open meeting laws, prior to taking certain actions relating to the funding, acquisition, or use of military equipment. The term “military equipment” is defined in California Government Code Section 7070.

Assembly Bill 481 allows the governing body of a City to approve the funding, acquisition, or use of military equipment within its jurisdiction only if it makes specified determinations.

The proposed military use policy is found within National City Police Department Policy 706.

The City Council of the City of National City will have the second reading of this ordinance and consider its adoption at the regular meeting to be held on March 15, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. in the National City Council Chamber, 1243 National City Boulevard, National City, California.
