Shooting Investigation

On Wednesday, July 20, 2022, at about 2102 hours, officers responded to the intersection of East 16th Street and Euclid Avenue in National City to investigate a report of a person who had been shot. NCPD officers arrived on scene and found the 16-year-old male victim on the ground suffering from a gunshot wound to the head. Officers gave emergency first aid to the victim. Medics arrived and the victim was immediately taken to a local trauma center where he is currently on life support. His injury is considered non-survivable. The victim's name is not being released at this time.

NCPD detectives responded to the scene and took over the investigation. Witnesses describe three unknown suspects running away from the scene. The suspects ran eastbound on East 16th Street. The National City Police Department is asking for the public's assistance in solving this crime.
