The National City Police Department will have several displays for people to interact with during the event, including SWAT equipment, police vehicles and motorcycles, a K-9 demonstration, and more. We plan to share valuable safety information while having fun with everyone who comes to the event. There will even be a dunk tank that will give attendees a once in a lifetime opportunity to send a uniformed police officer crashing into a tank of water!

Our very own National City Fire Fighter heroes will also be on scene with us grilling free hamburgers and hotdogs for the first 500 participants. NCFD firefighters will also hold a simulated demonstration on how they use special equipment to extract a driver or passenger from a badly damaged vehicle.

We have partnered with over thirty businesses and organizations from the National City and San Diego area. These businesses and organizations are excited to interact with everyone and to share their message, including swag, food, and more.
