- Morgan Tower (152 Units)
 - Completed on June20, 1979
 - 11,185 days of service
 - 0 1,700,120 service nights

Housing Demand

- Morgan Tower 165 seniors on waiting list; 2-3 years
- Kimball Tower 250 seniors on waiting list: 3 years

Other Local Senior Developments

 Four other senior developments reported a waiting period of 1½ to 3 years

- For Rent and Low Income




















