Camacho Center

- Camacho is currently offering open gym hours to serve our public. Different sports schedules throughout the week, such as Soccer, Basketball, and Volleyball
- Basketball classes for ages 4-8 years old and 9-11 years old are currently being hosted Mondays and Wednesdays. Parents have the option of registering youth for a 6, 8, or 10-week season. This program has had a total of 26 participants during our spring season. The season is scheduled to end on March 29th.
- Soccer classes for ages 8-10 are being offered at Camacho Tuesdays & Friday. We currently have 30 participants registered

El Toyon

El Toyon Recreation Center is currently hosting Ballet Folklorico Spring program.
 Classes take place Monday through Thursday for all ages. We currently have 103 participants registered.

Public Works- Parks Division

Work completed in March 2023: spray weeds in medians; worked ballfields; picked debris off streets from the storms; weed abatement (various locations).

In addition, 8 trees were trimmed, 28 trees removed, and 5 trees stumped.

Manuel Portillo Casa de Salud Youth Center

- The ESPORTS Afterschool program continues for youth 8-17. This program provides
 the youth with an opportunity to participate in competitive gaming while socializing in
 person as well as learning how to use a 3D printer, Cricut machine, and put together a
 computer from scrap parts. The youth that signed up are really happy to have this free
 program.
 - The ESPORTS program has been hosting an hour of physical activity which the youth have really enjoyed and started to take walking field trips to Kimball Park once a week when weather permits.

- In addition to walking to the park, the youth have been conducting trash pickups at Kimball Park and Paradise Creek Park once a week.
- Morning Socials are held at Casa de Salud on Tuesday and Thursday. Approximately 60 seniors registered for this program.
 - Morning Socials invite seniors to participate in two hours of activities and socializing.
 - Activities include arts & crafts, dancing, karaoke, celebrations, coffee, and snacks.
 - This month we had a representative from Humana visited and provided resources to the senior participants as well as coffee.
 - Crochet class has been very popular and the seniors have enjoyed all the new projects
 - The seniors had a St. Patrick's Day-themed dance.
- Senior Socials continue however the March one Senior Saturday had to be canceled due to the weather
