Traffic Control Plan Requirements Checklist

ALL TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS ACCOMPANYING UTILITY PERMIT APPLICATIONS SHALL CONFORM THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- Conform to latest edition of San Diego Regional Standard Drawings SDRSD Appendix A TCP-01 through TCP-55. (Conform to latest revision of CA MUTCD Part 6 where applicable).
- Prepared to standard scale 1" = 60' or 1" = 80' when printed on 11"x17" paper, printed in grayscale.
- Separate approval required for work in Caltrans or another municipality's ROW

TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS SHALL CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING:

- Description of work
- Permit number on traffic control notes pages
- Completed and signed applicant box on traffic control notes page
- Posted speed limits
- North arrow and scale
- Legend of symbols and abbreviations used
- List of signs proposed for permit
- The street segment/intersection containing the location of the project work area
- Include Match Lines when there are several phases of work or work is shown on multiple sheets
- Raised medians identified
- Traffic directional arrows
- Pedestrian accommodations/path indicated
- Dimensions for street widths (curb to curb), vehicular traffic lanes, bike lanes and bike buffers and parking lanes
- The location and dimensions for special curb zones include red, yellow, white, green and blue. Also show and dimension any bus stop zones and driveway openings.
- Flashing arrow boards as required
- Detour plan as required

*We reserve the right to request additional information and details following the initial submittal based on the complexity of the scope, severity of the restriction within the right of way, and field conditions including speed limit, type of road, traffic patterns, level of service, etc.
