- Westside Specific Plan Amendment and Amending the Zoning Text and Map of the Westside Specific Plan; and
- 4) Municipal Code Amendments, which include Chapter 18.49 to Provide Objective Design Standards for Housing Development, Adopting Chapter 18.50 to Provide a Floor Area Ratio Bonus Program, Adopting Amendments to Chapters 18.29 (Overlay Zones) to Create a Mixed-Use Overlay Zone to Allow Residential Development on Certain Parcels Zoned CL and CS, and Amending the Municipal Code to Revise Title 18; and
- 5) Update to the Bicycle Master Plan

The City's General Plan serves as the guiding document for achieving the community's vision for the future. It was last updated in 2011, and with new State legislation in March 2020, National City initiated the Focused General Plan Update (FGPU). One environmental document, a Supplemental Program Environmental Impact Report (SPEIR), was prepared to analyze the FGPU and related documents. It will have a separate public hearing on the same date and time.
