

Parcel Map










PROJECT PROPOSAL

Scope & Phasing



Gage Zero proposes to fund, develop, own and operate the ZE Truck Stop with:

- **~\$16M** capital investment
- 20 FTE construction jobs & 3 FTE O&M jobs

Phase 1:

- 10 x 350 kW dual-port chargers
- 2,500 sq ft driver amenity building
- 476 kW of on-site solar generation
- 500 kW / 2 MWh of battery storage
- Supports **67 trucks** to meet est. 44-78% of the Port's MCAS 2026 goal

Phase 2:

- 10 x 150 kW (or greater) dual-port chargers (when 20% utilization on Phase 1 achieved)
- Supports 96 trucks (total) to meet est. 46-81% of the Port's MCAS 2030 goal

Future Phase(s):

 Could expand EVSE, solar & storage based on charging demand and SDG&E system capacity





1. Harbor Drive & Civic Center Drive




2. Tidelands Ave mid-block (btwn W. 19th & Civic)
