

National City is set to see a significant enhancement to one of its cherished recreational areas—Pepper Park. The Port of San Diego Board of Port Commissioners has approved a Coastal Development Permit for a series of improvements to Pepper Park, located on the National City Bayfront. This project represents a major step towards transforming the park into an even more valuable resource for both visitors and residents.

Transformative Upgrades

The planned improvements aim to enhance the overall visitor experience at Pepper Park, making it a more attractive and functional space. Key elements of the project include:

- 1. Expanded Green Spaces and Picnic Areas
- 2. Upgraded Playgrounds
- 3. Improved Walking and Biking Paths
- 4. Enhanced Waterfront Access
- 5. New Amenities


Volunteers can sign up through the official Coastal Cleanup Day website. Early registration ensures that participants receive all necessary information and materials ahead of time.

The National City Library is bustling with activities this August, offering a wide array of events to engage the community. Here are some highlights:


- 1. Story Time for Kids:


