City Council Comments and Direction City Council

- In 2004 City Council goals were public safety, technology, fiscal clarity, community engagement and image
- In 2005 the City Council added the overarching goal of fiscal sustainability with a focus on the General Fund
- In 2006 National City reached a severe financial fork in the road survive or thrive was the question
- Citizens and businesses responded by supporting a secure temporary tax of 1% to create a city total of 2%* (+ state/county 7.75%)

- In 2007 we completed our 5 Year Strategic Plan and began implementing it As a result National City is a vibrant and safer place
- In 2008 after four consecutive years of saving money we built our emergency reserves to a high of \$9 million from \$4.2 million in 2005
- In 2009 with the economy heading downward and costs rising we used \$1.5 million in reserve funds to balance the budget
- Maintenance of high service levels, particularly in public safety was the policy directive of that budget cycle

- On January 30th, 2010 we held a community budget workshop to review our priorities and our financial position
- We reviewed impacts in our budget created by the worst economic environment in over 50 years
- Staff provided CARE ideas, financial trending and short term recommendations to close the **FY 09/10** estimated budget gap of \$ 3.3 million (at midyear)
- Today we are at another financial fork in the road that requires immediate action and more community engagement

- To date we have had 5 financial presentations for City Council and community
- Assistant City Manager and City Manager have met with all 7 Neighborhood Councils
- Have held discussions with 3 Labor Groups in National City (FFA, MEA, POA)
- Following this meeting we will have discussions with every department to further communicate our situation

City Manager Message

- My message to the City Council and organization is blunt – We must again cut expenses
- We must look at the impacts of both short term decisions and long term decisions
- The option of no cuts is not a prudent one and a one year option at best
- With this as a backdrop we are framing this interactive exercise with citizens as **program and service cuts**
- This is intended to be a *Budget Guide* for the City Council

Overview of Interactive Process

- We will provide budget information and the amount we are targeting to save (approximately \$5 to \$7 million dollars)
- We will make assumptions that a tax increase is not an option and that the using the contingency reserve is limited
- We will structure questions as follows:

 Maintain Reduce Eliminate
- We will try to define the dollars saved by the recommendations as well as the potential service impacts/consequences
- We will begin with the largest programs and functions



Sales Tax and District Tax Combined Revenue




General Fund Contingency Reserve

General Fund Policy: ... range between 25% and 50% of a single year's General Fund operating expenditures

- FY 10-11 Estimated General Fund expenditures = \$39.3 million
 - Reserve will be at 22%, which is \$1.2 million below target level of \$9.8 million

(\$39.3 million x 25%)






General Fund Revenue and Expenditure Forecast






General Fund Expenditures by Function/Program

General Fund Expenditures Percentage by Department




Public Safety Camera Project







General Fund Expenditures Percentage by Department




Homeland Security





















General Fund Expenditures Percentage by Department











General Fund Expenditures Percentage by Department






