✗ NOT Accepted Items:

- » TV's, VCR's
- » Computers, monitors
- » Air conditioners
- » Dirt, brick, blocks, or concrete
- » Construction or demolition rubble
- » Tires
- » Hazardous Waste: *NO* gas, solvents, pesticides, chemicals, rat poison, electronic devices, motor oil, paint, batteries, spray cans, pool chemicals, compressed gas, etc.
